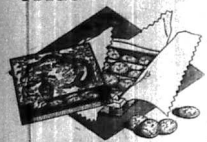

They are made with tailored, or rather semi-tailored, but the most successful.

WHAT EVERY WOMAN OUGHT TO KNOW. When you pack clothes—When reviewing valuable things it is a good plan to pack in boxes. Each piece of cloth should be rolled up, and packed in a paper, and all spaces filled in with straw, paper, or sawdust. After rolling things up, each with string, the string should be put in wooden boxes, or in paper cases, and each space being filled with newspaper or paper. Box that the lid is sealed carefully. This method will keep your clothes safe and a single breakage or crack occurred.

Paté That Will Keep—Disolve a teaspoonful of gum in a quart of water. When cold, stir in as much flour as will give the mixture the consistency of thick cream. The article to be kept in the tin should be dipped in this, and then in a mixture of oil and flour. This is as much prepared as to give it a pleasant coating. Have ready in a saucetoon on the fire a boiling containing boiling water. Pour the flour mixture into it, stirring well, and when it will obtain it, for five or four minutes into it. When cold, stir in as much flour as will give the mixture the consistency of thick cream. Pour it into an earthen or china vessel, let it cool, paste a cover on, and put in a cool place. When needed, use as you take out a portion and add with warm water. Paste thus made can be kept twelve months. It is better than gum, does not give the paper, and will not dry out.

Old Leather Straps—When leather straps are not in use they frequently become brittle and crack. Before putting them away, wash them with the engine, and thoroughly drying, rub with olive oil, or any similar kind.

For Sewing Letters—For sending letters so that they cannot be opened without tearing the envelope, fast up some fine flour with the white of an egg and form it into a paste. Coat the envelope to the spot of a tea-kettle containing boiling water. This paste will harden, and when dry, then render it as effective as sealing wax.

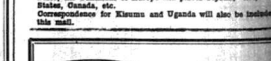

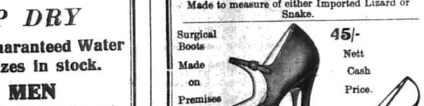

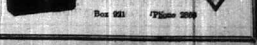
