Failure to Solve the Sino-Japanese Problem.

A WEAK POLICY.

Two Countries Left to Come to Terms Themselves?

The League of Nations is apparently finding the Sino-Japanese problem practically insoluble and something like consternation has been caused at Geneva by the suggestion that nothing definite is likely to result from the protracted discussion of the situation.

Japanese circles seem to have a likelihood that China will be advised not to insist on the withdrawal of Japanese troops as a preliminary to negotiations for settlement.

It is pointed out that this would mean that any discussion between the disputing parties would take place under the pressure of Japanese military occupation.

Unless some other way out is found it is considered that the position will rest squarely on the League of Nations and on the forthcoming Disarmament Conference.

REVOLUTION BREAKS OUT IN CYPRUS.

Government House Burned Down by Mob.

DEMAND FOR UNION WITH GREECE.

Naval and Military Forces Sent by Sea and Air.

A revolution has broken out in Cyprus following a demand by Greek Nationalist union with Greece.

A mob headed by three of the Elected Members of the Legislative Council marched on Government House which they burned to ground.

The Governor was compelled to cede to assistance to Malta and Egypt. Troops were immediately sent from Alexandria by air and sea, whilst two cruisers of the Mediterranean Fleet left Crete for Cyprus.

The revolution was precipitated by the Great Prime proclaiming the union of the island with Greece.

Instigated by Clergy.

The Governor of Cyprus is endeavoring to limit "riot" the movement of Malta asking for very assistance contrary to the demands which have broken out on the island today.

Communications regarding military assistance have passed between Cyprus and the Egyptian Government.

Appeal for Help.

Great disturbances have broken out in Cyprus.

It is said that telegrams from the island state that mobs are burning Government House and other buildings. Troops are being dispatched by sea and air to assist in the emergency. Mobs are said to be attacking and robbing the police.

Chaos of the Trouble.

The Cyprus trouble is apparently due to the Greek Nationalist movement. According to an Athens dispatch, the Greek Government has been asked to assist in the union of the island with Greece on the ground that the revolution is the will of the population despite the wishes of the Government.

The message added that members of the Cyprus Legislature had tendered their resignation.

Troops Dispatched.

A later message from Cairo states that the British Government has decided to send a large force to Cyprus at its present command. It is stated that the force will be sent to Cyprus by sea and air. The force is expected to arrive in Cyprus by the end of the month.

BRITAIN SPRINGS A SURPRISE.

U.S. Credit Almost Repaid.

New York Placated.

FULLY REPAYED LOAN TO BE "FROZEN"

The British Government has announced that it has repaid almost the full amount of the \$100 million loan to the United States. The loan was originally intended to be repaid over a period of 10 years, but the British Government has decided to repay it immediately. The loan is now being "frozen" and will not be repaid until the end of the year.

CHESS

(By A. M. Spencer Palmer, L.L.M., Barrister at Law, High Court Bench, P.O. Box 78, Nairobi.)

NOTES

It is generally agreed among chess experts that we have nothing in our "royal and ancient" game exactly comparable to the "old widgeo", but some writers suppose that we can run better very chess.

On my last voyage to England I travelled by the same ship as my wife, and I played a certain amount of chess. She "knew the moves" but does not play. In fact, like the wives of the ancient prophets who did not expect to be taken seriously in the domestic circle, my wife inclined to the belief that our chessplayer in the family is either a trick, or after any other deal for this matter, on my way to one of these I would often notice Mrs. A. H. S. P. reading, or doing sewing, or possibly knitting, the mysteries of "L.W.H." On such occasions I would naturally pause a moment in my way to the board and make some kindly remark such as "Nice day, or 'I hope you sleep well," or "I passed along one day someone said to my wife 'If that gentleman a friend of yours Mrs. Palmer'?" "No," said she, "that's my husband."

THE LAWS OF CHESS.

I have received a complimentary copy of a little book of these laws just compiled and issued by the "F.I.D.E." (Federation Internationale des Echecs).

The price is 7/6 post free, and the Secretary's name and address is Mr. E. F. Bees, "St. Aubyn's," Bebban, Surrey.

Every player should get a copy. The laws are revised and dated accordingly simple and definite in their meaning. There are also some valuable additions to the former codes. One which pleased me very much runs as follows:—

"If the player touch several

of his own men, the Opponent has the right to seize which of them the player shall move.

It is to be noted that this might do a lot to help people from the "fence" and "fencing" a few men, as if they were being by the foot of them, which was their chief business, like the British brigadier deciding whether he would "fence" or "play" in the "Amateur", or especially, upon valuable rule by regular the standard of play and up-keep.

One interesting rule of another code was to try square on the board for the purpose of facilitating receding possible moves.

Another good example:—No analysis of games shall be allowed in tournament Chess.

This means that while match games are proceeding it is now illegal to discuss games involving the chess player in the family.

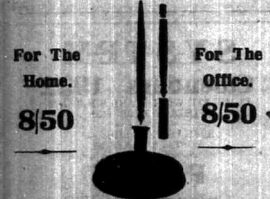

REVOLUTION IN CYPRUS STAMPED OUT.

Effect of Naval and Military Display.

CAUSE OF THE OUTBREAK.

Inflammatory Speech by Greek Bishop.

M. Venizelos, the Greek Premier, condemned the disturbances in Cyprus, which he described as criminal excesses. He ridiculed the idea that such a small island could be Britain to satisfy the national aspirations of Greeks in Cyprus.

The troubles appear to have started on October 30, when the Greek Bishop of Larnaca, raised a cross and appealed to a mass meeting, "in the Name of God and the Fatherland," to fight for union with Greece.

The arrival of seven Air Force troop-carriers with troops bringing reinforcements had its effect on the rebels who dispersed. Previously the mob raided military lorries carrying supplies to out-

posts. For seven hours Nicolaos was in the mob. All the personal belongings of the Governor, Sir Ronald Cross, a valuable collection of pictures and other irreplaceable art treasures were destroyed when Government House was burned down.

A latest message from Cairo states that the situation is now normal, the display of naval and military forces having effectively stamped out the disturbances.

Art Treasures Destroyed.

(THROUGH REUTERS AGENCY.) Athens, October 30. "Criminal ransoms" was the Greek Premier's denunciation of the disturbances at Cyprus during the morning. 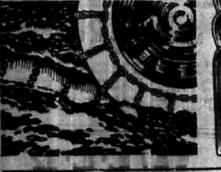

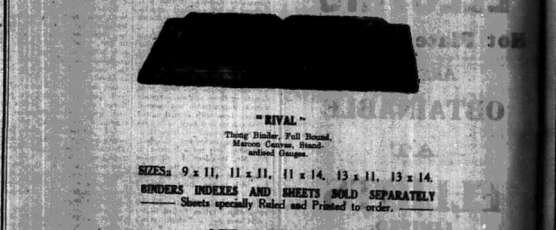
