LONGER TOURS IN UGANDA.

Scheme Proposed by the Finance Committee.

SPECIAL ENQUIRY SUGGESTED.

Remarkable List of "Special Allowances" to Officers.

The Finance Committee appointed some time ago by the Government of Uganda consisting of three official and three unofficial members has produced its second report.

The unofficial members were strongly of the opinion that awards of service in Uganda were usually small and although there was a claim of very serious cases and that certain members it was recommended that the Awards Committee report on the same subject should be considered and approved by a special enquiry committee in Uganda.

In the meantime the Finance Committee made certain broad recommendations based on the living conditions and on length of service.

A large section of the Report has reference to what are known as "special allowances" and in the majority of cases abolition is unanimously recommended.

Even such things as frivolous or unnecessary calls by an official's family for medical attention at Government expense were discouraged.

The Report criticises adversely the system which has grown of appointing deputies particularly in the smaller departments.

In regard to passage privileges the view is expressed that despite the facilities created by the limited second class accommodation, young officers should travel second class, whatever the nature of their appointments.

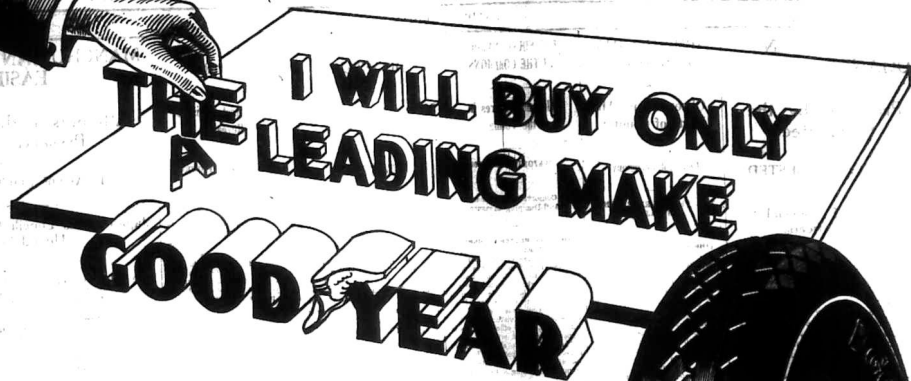

midweek (which was composed of an equal number of officials and non-officials) proposed that in this basin during the first 14 days' service leave should be taken at the rate of five days per month in Class A districts, in Class B, and seven in Class C. During the 14th and subsequent years of service the basis would be seven and eight days respectively.

Traveling Allowance. In regard to travelling allowance it was proposed that the Government should continue to draw the present rates during 1921, but that during 1922 the new scale applied in Kenya and Tanganyika should be adopted, or alternatively the payment of travelling allowance should be suspended.

Special Allowance. The Report therefore passes under review a large number of special allowances which appear in the Uganda Budget. In some cases which abolition is recommended it is suggested that the allowance should be abolished at once if it is not considered that the Government should decide whether this step can be taken without injustice or hardship.

It is proposed that out-of-office allowances should be abolished except in the case of nursing sisters and police officers.

With certain exceptions the Committee recommended that Government should consider whether any money could be effected by providing offices with the necessary number of uniform instead of paying them as special allowances.

His Honor the Chief Justice of the High Court (the Chief Secretary) took notice of 250 special allowances to make the Chief Secretary's speech. The Finance Committee recommended that these allowances should be abolished. The Public Officers' Mess in Kampala has been in receipt of a special allowance of £25. The Government has decided that if contingencies of the mess would be provided for two officers for whom alternative accommodations would be provided by Government and would further affect economy by providing temporary accommodation for officers visiting Kampala whose hotel expenses would otherwise have to be paid by Government and if generally Government was satisfied that the institution would be less prone of value in providing a means of saving and discipline within the Force, this grant should be abolished at the end of 1921 per annum.

Special allowances of £10 per annum are paid to nursing sisters who are posted for duty in native hospitals. The Finance Committee were divided on the question of continuation. The medical members expressed the view that the terms of appointment of nursing sisters should cover duties in native and military hospitals without any special allowance and that the allowance would only be justified when a sister was called upon to supervise a hospital. The official members, however, considered that the allowance was justified, this having regard to the nature of the duties which are required to perform in native hospitals.

A European officer in the Education Department draws £20 per annum as "Secretary of the Langford House." The Committee, however, unimpressed by the high-sounding title, considered that the allowance should be abolished.

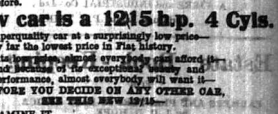
