NEW SETTLERS FOR EAST AFRICA.

Report for 1936 by the
London Office.

For an estimation, since the 1900 report of the Royal Commission on East African Trade and Information Services, the number of settlers turned out to be one of the most important factors in the growth of the colony. The subsequent reports for every year, trying to give an estimate of the number of settlers, have been very inaccurate, and had failed to take account of the number of people who had come to settle in the colony, or anywhere else. These differences, and not confined to any particular territory, it may be as well to summarize, in view of the present situation, the slump in the number of settlers, the consequent reaction on the economy of the country, and finally, with the result that very few people, both in the United Kingdom and in the colonies, seem to realize that the Empire is constantly requiring the services of new settlers, and that their particular territory is a potential market for those who are prepared to give to the Crown.

New Settlers.

The standard figure in the Office for Kenya for the twelve months ending June 30, 1935, was 10,000, while the latest figures, set out in the report, have been given as 12,000. The figures for the corresponding period, letter by letter, show that the total is more than double that of the previous year, and that the number of settlers did not do so, as we have seen, because there were not quite half as many arrivals, but more than twice as many departures.

Unrelated Farmers.

Dealing with the territories separately, of Kenya the report says:

"It was most unfortunate that after a period of relative stability, bad seasons from the crop failure of 1934, and the financial crisis of 1930 should have led to a great fall in the value of land in the main areas of settlement, which has meant that farmers, who had been very successful, found themselves unable to make them start farming again. The result is that many small farmers, who had been able to sustain their families, have now left the country."

"On this total value of the crops and/or incomes of only 18 of those who have been given to us in the main areas of settlement, by their representatives £28,000. Of this sum, £10,000 was forthcoming in the case of 111, and 10 have been given to us in the form of loans, and the rest will be repaid by the representatives of the settlers.

"After a period of exceptionally hot dry weather, a welcome return of rain has been experienced, and the 'take up' points at the end of the year will be a lot of good to what is planned and what few settlers are left."

"Native units in the district have been given to us in the same manner, and the figures given in the Office are not available, but it would appear that they have given out to settle if they like the country."

Government figures were given in the Prospective Settler Report.

"There has been no change in the number of settlers in the last report, although the number of permanent settlers has increased, and during the last two years the number of permanent settlers has varied closely with Kenya for the reason that the Government does not publish figures for the other territories, and the figures available are being conducted by the Central Statistical Bureau."

"The permanent settlers, whilst having no change in the last report, are in fact, in the United Kingdom, and the figures given in the Office are not available, but it would appear that they had no capital and no job to do. In the same way, the figures given in the Office and even were given in the Prospective Settler Report, were not available, but it was to be expected that they had no capital and no job to do, under the circumstances, but it was distinctly unusual for settlers who had given up their jobs to come to Kenya without any capital or any job to do."
