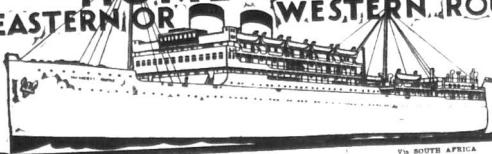

EAST AFRICA'S GREATEST PUBLIC FIGURE.

Thirty Years' Contribution to the Empire.

HIS WORK FOR KENYA.

Pioneer of Economic and Political Development of the Colony.

The "East African Standard" deeply regrets to announce the death at his Kabete home, Nairobi, shortly after 3 o'clock, on Friday, November 18, of the Rt. Hon. Lord Delamere, K.C.M.G., after an illness lasting nearly a fortnight.

The cause of death was heart failure.

As his death the Empire in Africa, and in particular the Colony of Kenya, loses a public figure whose qualities of statesmanship during 30 years entitle him to be compared in his creative capacity with Cecil Rhodes.

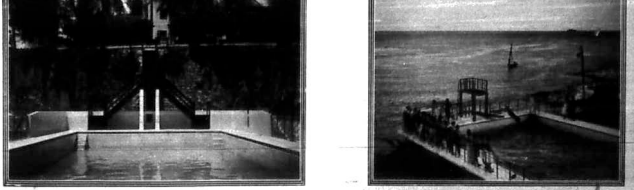

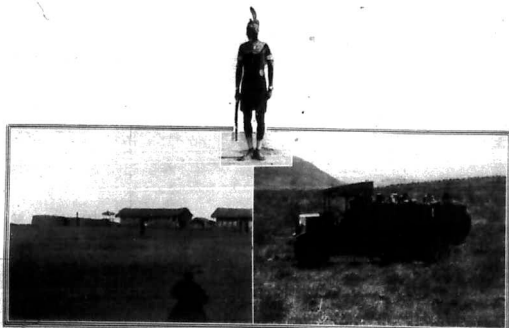
