SITUATION BECOMING CRITICAL.

President of Congress Also Taken into Custody.

Gandhi has been arrested by order of the Government of India. The warrant merely stated that the cause of the arrest was for "not being a sufficient taxpayer". Vallabhai Patel, President of the Congress, has also been taken into custody. Both were removed to a cell at Poona.

Gandhi was arrested under an Ordinance which gives power to the Government to place him under restraint during his absence.

The warrant was executed during the early hours of the morning, a party of policemen headed by the Commissioner, visiting Gandhi's house at 3 a.m. On being awakened and shown the warrant, Gandhi merely smiled, as it was his day of silence. He merely smiled.

A small gathering of supporters had Gandhi farewell, many weeping bitterly, but precautions were taken to avoid any demonstration.

A "War Council" headed by a "dictator" has been appointed in Calcutta, and will direct the civil disobedience campaign, now President of the Congress was selected by Patel on his arrest.

A Message to the Viceroy.

London, January 8.—While there is no immediate expectation that an Ordinance will be passed prohibiting the flagging of the Congress and prohibiting its members from holding public meetings, his own arrest is significant. Gandhi is imprisoned after the Congress and spent the night in custody. In reply to the Viceroy's statement, he expressed his deep regret at the Government's decision and expressed the opinion that it was wrong to detain an honest man on suspicion of treason. He stated that the Delhi Congress was conducted with strict discipline and was active, and that the Poona was more orderly and was not disrupted by Government interference. He stated that he believed that the Government policy should be to release Gandhi upon his promise, and that the Government should be made to carry out the program without undue delay or any further violence.

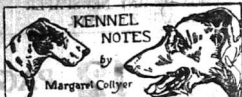

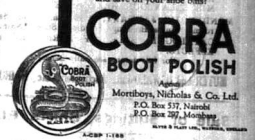
