JAPANESE FORCES MASSING FOR ATTACK ON ENORMOUS SCALE.

Both of the British Nauru ratings who were wounded by a Chinese attack which fell into the International Settlement of Shanghai, have since died. They were guarding a wharf on the Whangpoo River.

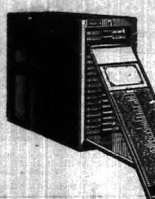

IS KENYA INCREASING LOCAL USE OF THE IMPORTED VARIETY?

The Governments of Uganda and Tanganyika have decided not to apply the suspended duty of Shs. 1/10 per bag, which was on wheat and wheat flour which they agreed to do in December last.

This means that whereas wheat imported for consumption in Kenya will now cost only Shs. 9/- per bag, it will cost only Tanganyika and Uganda at Shs. 6/-, for four days in respect of Kenya will be Shs. 12/- per 200 lbs. but only Shs. 9/- for the other two territories.

The most recent figures show that Uganda's importations of foreign flour have fallen slightly, while on the other hand the Kenya consumption of imported flour has apparently increased, although import figures began to fall at the end of the year.

At the same time the exports of Kenya flour, both to Tanganyika and Uganda, fell during 1931 by more than 100 per cent, with the average monthly quantity falling during the latter half of the year.

It is not expected that there will be any surplus wheat for export from Kenya this year.

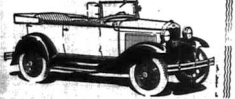

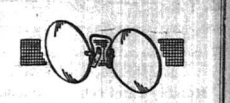
