Tokyo, February 23.—Japan has replied to the League of Nations' appeal, in a note which calls into question the validity of certain of the League's actions. It emphasizes that China cannot be regarded as an organized State owing to her constant civil war, disorder and anarchy, and denies that China is seeking a pacific settlement, in spite of her lip service.

The attitude in the vicinity of Shanghai is continuing, and the Japanese advance has been checked. The Chinese army is now vigorously replying to the Japanese bombardment, now having received a fresh supply of ammunition.

Chapei and Kiangwan, the objectives of the Japanese attacks, is still in Chinese hands, and all attempts to dislodge them have failed. Two divisions of troops which were being despatched from Japan as reinforcements.

Mr. John Simon, the Foreign Secretary, outlined the British policy in connexion with the situation in China. Britain, he said, would direct her full influence, in conjunction with other Powers, to support the League of Nations. All British interests would be fully protected.

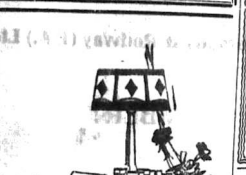

not intended to put forward a case in maintaining the status quo in East Africa. It is intended to point out to the British Government that it is to be feared that the British territories covered by the seals have not been very carefully examined by the House of Commons. It is made accordingly.

### Britain's Occupation.

The emergency existing in the British industry has been emphasized by the imposition of the Tariff Bill of 1929. This measure increased the average rate of tariff from 27% to 37%. The total amount of tariff duty on the value of the goods imported into this country during the year 1930 was estimated at £120,000,000. ### Import Duty Proposed.

(4) A drawback system be applied if required on D.K. exports of manufacturers on leaving foreign land.

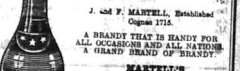
