Japan's reply to the League's note has been handed to the President of the Council at Geneva... It places the blame for the existing state of affairs upon China, and demands the previous statement that Japan has no territorial ambitions.

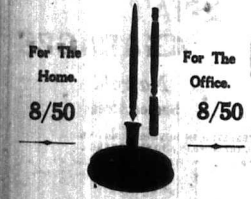

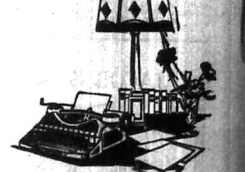

President of the Board of Trade warmly repudiated Mr. Linn's view and supported the grant of Preference to British Mandated Territories.

Extremists at Work.

London, February 25. (By the Mail.) The House of Commons has today passed a resolution which will be regarded as a serious step towards the proposed inclusion of the mandated territories in the Empire.

It will be recalled that Mr. W. Linn, who has been appointed to the post of Under-Secretary of State for the Colonies, has today announced that he will be resigning from the post.

The following is the report of a lecture given by Mr. J. J. James, Government Entomologist, on control methods for the coffee mealybug.

The problem of repellents and of their use has been the subject of considerable attention in recent years. While entomologists are of the opinion that repellents can be used to some extent in the control of many species of insects, the present-day repellents are generally of a purely physical nature. The types of repellents used have been repellents of the kind known as "contact" repellents. **The Great Difficulty.**  
The special difficulty associated with the control of mealybug ants is the fact that they are not only very active, but they are also very tenacious. He said that the Government was not prepared to make any concession which would be a disadvantage to the country.
