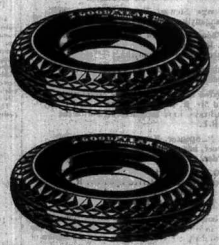

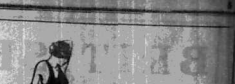

### Dramatic Announcement in Parliament

#### Mr. de VALERA'S INVITATION TO BRITAIN.

#### A Meeting in Dublin.

#### PRELIMINARY DISCUSSION ON EXISTING DIFFICULTIES.

A dramatic announcement was made on Monday in the House of Commons by Mr. J. H. Thomas, Secretary for the Dominions, to the effect that Mr. de Valera had invited the British Government to a preliminary discussion in Dublin, on the present Anglo-Irish difficulties.

The British Government accepted this invitation and Mr. Thomas and Lord Halifax left London on the same evening. The conversations will be resumed in London later in the week.

The British Press generally accepts of the acceptance of the invitation, the notable exception being the "Morning Post," which states that Mr. de Valera is simply trying to throw the responsibility on to Britain. "The Times" while welcoming the conference says that Mr. de Valera has realised that his policy was leading to disaster.

Mr. W. T. Cosgrave, the leader of the Opposition in the Dail, states that the Free State Government has simply adopted the opposition's policy, which course should have been followed in the first instance.

#### Mr. Thomas Leaves London.

London, June 6. Mr. J. H. Thomas, Secretary for the Dominions, announced today that Mr. de Valera had invited the Government to discuss in Dublin on the present difficulties between the two countries in connection with the Oireachtas Conference.

Mr. Thomas is leaving for Dublin tonight, accompanied by Lord Halifax, Secretary for War. Mr. de Valera has agreed to resume the conversations in London on Friday.

The dramatic change in the Anglo-Irish situation, marked by Mr. de Valera's invitation to the House of Commons had been given credit to the newspaper.

Approved of the British Government's action is the general acceptance of the invitation, which conditions the resumption of the negotiations. Mr. de Valera, who is regarded as the "strong" man of the Oireachtas Conference, is expected to be the main force in the present difficulties.

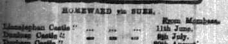
