RESULTS OF THE GREAT EMPIRE CONFERENCE.

Twelve Agreements Signed

INAUGURATION OF NEW ERA.

Promotion and Development of Imperial Trade.

The British delegates were given an enthusiastic send-off when they left Ottawa at the conclusion of the great Empire Conference. His Majesty the King telegraphed a message of appreciation on the fact that the delegates had concluded important practical agreements for the promotion of trade between the British Empire but also adopted principles to help its future development.

Before the Conference came to an end twelve agreements were signed, seven being bilateral and five between individual Dominions and Dominion.

All the agreements show a pronounced move towards the extension of preferential trade and the lowering of duties on raw materials within the Empire.

The agreements will mean more trade as soon as possible and also a period of five years, terminable at will, in which the British Empire will be gradually brought to a consultation between the two Governments concerned.

There are undertakings not to lower existing preferences and the principle of the extension of mutual preferences is in every agreement applied to Colonies and Protectorates.

The Extension of Preference.

London, August 21.—The Empire Conference has just concluded its work and is now on its way to the Commonwealth. The following are the main results of the conference: The British Government has agreed to extend its preference to the Dominion of Newfoundland for three years, terminable at will, in which the Dominion Government will be gradually brought to a consultation between the two Governments concerned. THE CANADIAN TREATY.

Creation of a Tariff Board.

The Canadian Treaty provides for the creation of a Tariff Board to be composed of representatives from both the Dominion and the United Kingdom. The Board will be responsible for the adjustment of duties on raw materials and for the extension of preferences to the Dominion of Newfoundland for three years, terminable at will, in which the Dominion Government will be gradually brought to a consultation between the two Governments concerned.

Samburu Penetration.

The Land Commission under the Chairmanship of Sir W. Merie Carter sat at Rumuruti on August 18 and heard the claims advanced by Laikipia settlers for the reversion of lands in their area for white settlement.

A lengthy memorandum, detailing the early history of the settlement in the neighbourhood, requested that "all claims previously acquired by the Maasi, in what is known as Laikipia, and which were vacated by them to make way for white settlement, should be definitely made available for that purpose and alienated as soon as possible."

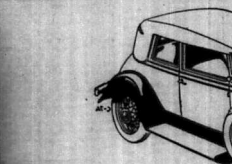

RECOMMENDATIONS BY THE ADVISORY COUNCIL.

Cost of Investigations.

ALL COUNTRIES CONCERNED TO BE INVITED TO CONTRIBUTE.

Following the review, published yesterday, by the Economic Advisory Council on Locust Control, on the locust position in Africa and Western Asia during the year ending July, 1921, the Council gives a series of recommendations for the carrying on of the work of investigation.

The cost of the work involved it is stated should be borne by means of subscriptions to the central fund by the Governments of the territories affected by the menace. It is hoped that Colonies concerned will continue to contribute as in the past, while other Governments should also be invited to co-operate both financially and in the furnishing of reports on the situation.

The widest possible distribution of the report of the Council is recommended. Foreign Governments it is also invited should be kept advised with an expression of hope that they will co-operate in the locust investigations.

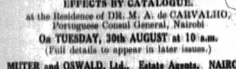

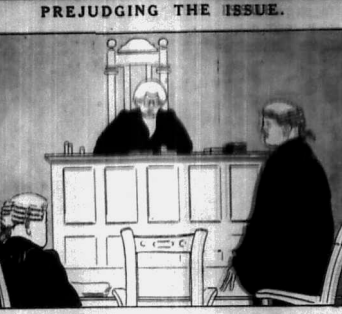
