**CHARGES OF INFLICTING POLITICAL WARFARE.**

The public in Germany has been reassured by the Government's reply to Herr Hitler and it is suggested that he has now played his last trump and his last. It is understood that Herr Hitler across the desks of the von Papen Government the Reichstag will be dissolved.

In that event the case of voters would be raised by the Government. This would have the effect of depriving a large number of voting Nazis and Communists of their votes. A National Assembly would then be chosen by the voters and a new constitution drawn. In effect this would mean the abolition of proportional representation.

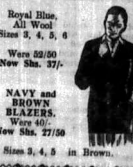

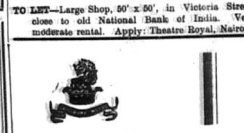
