Dr. He went out to India as a member of the Indian Medical Service at the age of 25 and conducted the great study of malaria in 1902. He was awarded India's highest honor three years later.

It was in 1905 that the British Board undertook the experimental verification of the merozoite theory of malaria, and he discovered the life history of the merozoite parasite in malarial, in 1907. In 1910, he was awarded the Nobel Prize. When news reached that he was to be made the Duke of Devon, he was indelible. While in India he worked conscientiously for the benefit of the people, and the history of the merozoite parasite was the result of his work. A Valuable Address.

EXISTING ECONOMIC CONDITIONS - PRESENT A DIFFICULTY.

A most interesting and instructive address was given at the weekly luncheon meeting of the Nairobi Rotary Club on Friday by the Hon. H. B. Scott, Director of Education, who took as his subject the progress of the future of Kenya youth after leaving school.

He pointed out that the number of children leaving school in this country has risen overseas was becoming less, and was an important factor in that it might indicate that Kenya was becoming a country of colonial rather than of a self-sufficient nation.

After referring to the problem of those children who left school completely before reaching the age of 15, those future outlook he described as grim. Mr. Scott proposed to deal with the after-school life of those who left at the normal age. He dealt with figures of the country, and the social structure of the Colony; and dwelt upon the need for more technical, educational authorities and numbers of schools generally to see that they were more of absorption.

Existing economic conditions presented the greatest difficulty at the present time, and it was hoped to encourage boys to follow the rural calling of the country. He also emphasized the need for some form of social service to aid young people in their future careers after leaving school.

Absorption in Social Structure.

He, H. B. Scott, Director of Education, said that the present situation in Kenya was a difficult one. He pointed out that the number of children leaving school in this country has risen overseas was becoming less, and was an important factor in that it might indicate that Kenya was becoming a country of colonial rather than of a self-sufficient nation. He dealt with figures of the country, and the social structure of the Colony; and dwelt upon the need for more technical, educational authorities and numbers of schools generally to see that they were more of absorption.

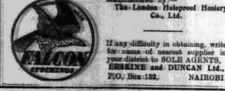

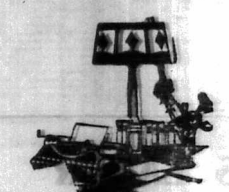

Germany and the British Memorandum.

GENERAL DISAPPOINTMENT AT TONE.

"Unfriendly and Unjustified"

MR. ARTHUR HENDERSON APPEALS FOR CAUSE OF DISARMAMENT.

The British memorandum on the question of Germany's equal equality in armaments has been received with disappointment throughout that country. It is maintained that Germany cannot accept the British request that a political sense of vast implications has been raised without sufficient cause.

The suggestion made by France that a committee should be appointed to investigate Germany's alleged illegal armaments has met with approval. A spokesman declaring that any German Government "would rightly be treated like a runaway dog if it permitted foreign Powers to exercise such control over Germany."

A strong appeal has been made by Mr. Arthur Henderson, the President of the Disarmament Conference, for Germany to reconsider her withdrawal from the Conference. Her prolonged absence, he believes, might seriously affect the cause of general disarmament.

The French Suggestion.

British Ambassador to Paris has been informed that the Disarmament Conference has been suspended in Germany's appeal for equality in armaments. The suggestion is that the British Government should have been more explicit and offering more definite proposals.

President Henderson this morning arrived here via Paquet, en route to the view of the Cabinet of the British Government.

A Government spokesman said he was not aware of any British proposal being made. He said that the British Government has issued a statement in which the British Government has stated that it is in a measure satisfied by the terms of the memorandum on the subject.
