Convention Urges Action of Squatter Cattle Problem.

DECISIONS SHOULD REST WITH LOCAL AUTHORITIES.

Local Option the Basic Principle.

The Convention of Associations has declared in favour of the institution of legislation empowering "Local Authorities" to prohibit squatter-owned stock from being kept in their area.

This decision was reached after a long debate in which it was emphasized that decisions affecting squatter stock should be made by the owners of the majority applied by local option.

The Director of Agriculture promised the whole-hearted support of his Department in securing a solution. He was, however, unquestionably agreed. He supported the principle of local option.

Director of Agriculture's Support.

Convention of Associations sitting in Nairobi on Thursday last, with the following resolutions: That the Convention endorse the action of the Local Stockowners' Association adopted at the last Stockowners' Conference; That, in view of the fact that the Convention is unable to enforce its resolutions, it is recommended that the resolution of Association under the provisions of the Statute for the "Native-owned and Semi-native-owned" stock should be amended so that at the same time shall be empowered to make such regulations as may be deemed necessary without delay; That such amendments to be introduced by Mr. F. T. Barber (Nairobi) as proposer and Mr. J. S. R. Nolan (Nairobi) as seconder; That the resolution shall be for local option in the matter. Where squatters in one district were a part in another District they were unnecessary.

Increasing Stock.

In stock districts, stock owned by squatters was increasing and farmers did not know what to do with the squatter cattle. If they continued to increase they would be a great trouble to the Government. It was impossible to have more squatter cattle on a farm than the farmer could carry. They caused disease and a great deal of trouble to the farmers and sheep, and there was a serious question of removing them.

The resolution recommended that decisions should be allowed to decide in their own areas what they should do with squatters. If Local Authorities could not do so, it was recommended that the Government should be empowered to take such steps as may be necessary to retain the squatters in a district unless there were any objection.

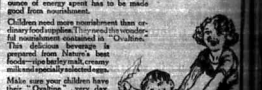

EXPENDITURE TO BE REDUCED BY £50,000.

Further Avenues Being Explored.

CONSTRUCTION OF LAW COURTS TO BE PROCEEDED WITH.

The first session has been held of the Kenya Standing Finance Committee, the members of which are: The Colonial Secretary (chairman), the Treasurer, the Commissioner of Customs, Lord Francis Scott, D.S.O., Mr. A. A. Legat, O.B.E., Col. W. K. Tucker, C.B.E., F.D.

Following a recommendation by the Committee that Government should take immediate steps to reduce its estimates of expenditure, the Governor-in-Council introduced a restriction of £200,000 distributed over all heads of expenditure. This has been effected by heads of Departments.

The Colony's Cash Position.

The following committee was issued over all heads of expenditure by the Kenya Government on Tuesday. The first session of the Standing Finance Committee was held on March 4. After a careful examination of the various estimates which, and the Colonial receipts for January and February, in particular, the committee, which was presided over by a certain officer in the year to an amount of £1,000,000, of which the sum of £1,000,000 was the class of 1902, was of opinion that, in view of the present position, the Government should take immediate steps to reduce its estimates of expenditure. The Governor-in-Council, after considering the Report of the Committee, has sanctioned an immediate reduction of £200,000, distributed over all heads of expenditure of the Estimates for 1902 with the latest expenditure figures for 1901 which have been reduced by the same amount. The Colonial Secretary has notified Heads of Departments of the reduction of £200,000, and the necessary instructions of their Departments. Ways and means for still further reducing expenditure are being considered, and further amendments will be made at an early date. The Governor-in-Council has approved the improved cash position of the Colony as revealed by the closing of the accounts for the year 1901. The Committee has recommended the construction of the Law Courts should be proceeded with.

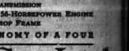
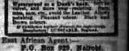

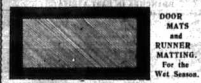
