

ENGLAND AT WAR!

DECIDED LAST NIGHT
Official Message Received
Grey's Great Speech
Germany's Ultimatum to Belgium

PRICE 10 CENTS EACH.

The French fleet was in the Mediterranean Sea while the northern coasts of France were defenceless. If a foreign fleet attacked these defenceless coasts Britain could not stand aside.

Sir Edward Grey stated the French ambassador yesterday evening that if the German fleet the Channel and North Sea, attacked French shipping or the coast, the British fleet would give all assistance in its power. This would not be a declaration of war as it was understood that Germany would be prepared, if she judged it expedient to neutrality, to agree not to attack the northern coast of France. Was that due too narrow an engagement for us? Then there was the question of the neutrality of Belgium.

Britain's interest in Belgium neutrality was as strong to-day as in 1870. When mobilisation began by (Sir Edward Grey) had telegraphed France and Germany on the subject. France had replied she would respect the neutrality. The German Foreign Secretary had replied he feared as was unable to answer because it would disclose plans. Then Britain was consulted as to whether the restoration of Belgium's integrity would satisfy us. He replied that we could not barter our obligations.

The King of Belgium telegraphed to King George a supreme appeal for diplomatic intervention to safeguard Belgian independence.

If the independence of Belgium went the independence of Holland went also. He asked the House whether the British interests were at stake. "If we so wish."

We had as yet taken no engagement in regard to any responsibility upon us of the country. We had had had the fleet, and the mobilisation of the army was proceeding. We were to be prepared, and we were prepared to face the consequences, using all our strength as a neutral nation we knew not how soon we might have to defend ourselves. If the situation developed as it seemed probable we would have believed that when the country realised what it has at stake it would support the Government in determination, resolution and endurance. Lord Roberts said, "Last week I stated that we were working for peace, not only for Britain, but to preserve the peace of Europe. Events had shown us that this was not so easy a thing as it appeared. It is now difficult to state the actual position of affairs. It is now clear that the peace of Europe cannot be preserved unless Russia and Germany have declared war on each other before they fight their position. The Government would like to clear the ground as to what obligations we owe to the House in its coming to a decision. Let me say very plainly, we persistently worked with all our resources in our power to preserve peace. (Cheers) The House may be satisfied on that point. Through the Balkan crisis we worked for peace and the cooperation of the Great Powers was necessary. It is true some Powers had great difficulties in coming to a decision, and it took much time, labour, and discussion before they could settle. The difficulties were not so serious because peace was their main object and they were willing to give their time and resources to accommodate their differences.

Until yesterday we had given no promise beyond that of diplomatic support. At about 4.30 a.m. this morning an official message from the Home Government to the effect that England was involved in war was received here. Further details are not yet to hand, but the events immediately preceding the outbreak are contained in the following cables received early this morning.

London, Monday.
From Stockholm it is reported that the German and Russian fleets fought an engagement near the island of Åland, in the north of the Baltic Sea, the Russian fleet being driven into the Gulf of Finland. The Germans have occupied the Åland Islands.

Fishburn report that a large Russian warship has gone ashore. Another states that the Russian papers report that Germany has sent an ultimatum to Belgium proposing an extension to facilitate German operations in Belgium and that it is semi-officially announced that Belgium has refused and adhere to neutrality.

In Australia a partial military mobilisation is taking place. In Paris there is a constant humming sound from aeroplanes proceeding toward the frontier. (Cheers) The Government has been asked for the airports at making profits by raising prices of aeroplanes. The Government has called up several aeroplanes. The Tower is continuous all night against aeroplane attacks.

At Malta the Mediterranean Fleet has been ordered to sea. It is believed to join the fleet at full speed, it is expected to join the "Indefatigable," "Weymouth" and "Dolphin," with two divisions of destroyers on command but with orders.

It is officially announced that Belgium has rejected Germany's ultimatum and depicts all methods to defend neutrality.

SIR EDWARD GREY'S SPEECH.
Sir Edward Grey addressing the Commons explained the British Government's obligation in the present crisis. He asked the House to regard the matter from the point of view of British opinion, honour, and obligation, and then from any practical point.

When the difficulties were published it would be seen how unexpected had been our efforts to maintain peace.
