A firm by the name of McCabe and Webber Limited of Block Buildings Margaret Street, London W. are doing a roaring trade with Swahili in British East Africa in Silver Watches. The system being adopted is a "Snowball" system. In the first instance it seems a Swahili sends three rupees to the firm and receives in return four certificates each of a nominal value of Rupees three (three shillings in England). The purchaser sells the four tickets for three rupees each, making twelve rupees. Three rupees of this he keeps for himself and the other nine rupees he forwards to the firm together with the four certificates sold to him to four other Swahilis bearing the name and address of the buyers. Upon receipt of the money and certificates the firm send an unquestionably silver watch to the original purchaser and four other lots of certificates to each of the persons introduced by him, these said certificates also bearing the right to a silver watch form. We do not quite see where the McCabe and Webber Ltd. come in, as time goes on we may be enlightened as may those who patronize the business.
