Nairobi Flooded.
Remarkable Scenes in Town.
A TORRENTIAL DOWNPOUR.

The heavy rains of Wednesday evening resulted in a severe inundation of the "good old days" of early Nairobi when the slightest shower transformed the swampy portions of the town into a veritable lake.

Extraordinary scenes were witnessed in 6th Avenue and Victoria Street, and in numerous other localities of the town. In the morning, from about 9 o'clock, the roadway from about the site of the Standard buildings to Mackintosh's corner, was a continuous torrent, in fact, which took the form of a furious waterfall. It was not until about 11 o'clock that the water subsided to a level which allowed the traffic to pass.

On the opposite side of the river, some four feet deep in places, several small boats were being towed towards Government Road, temporarily surging all below it, and clearing the thoroughfare of traffic.

The episode which was hazardous enough to leave the domestic circuit, and that of conveying the steamer underfoot, had a rough time of it. One of them, which was being hauled a long, perilous journey in the open street, which had been the scene of the unfortunate rider taking the water to the street through which he had to wade.

No less remarkable was the scene in Victoria Street, up into the old post office. The roadway, for a distance of about 300 yards, was completely blocked, hindering a passage over the spot, extremely inconvenient, as one could not tell when one's great would take a sudden plunge into one of the deep chasms which were the scene of the disaster.

In Duke Street, too, the situation of a "landslide" representative was called to the notice of the Commissioner of the Junction of River Road and the former thoroughfare. Half-naked, indeed, the scene of the post, was a veritable torrent, a flood of water, rushing everything in its way.

To render the navigation of this perilous and more precarious, the water in the wooden boards covered the drain referred to, and then heath, slightly by obstructions in any water, kept shifting and threatening at every moment to give way altogether.

It is fortunate, indeed, in view of the vicinity of the beef stores, that no great damage has been done, or reported, that no reports of serious personal injury have come to hand.

A result of the storm was that the Theatre Royal, although it did not show the usual programme of merry entertainments, the manager wisely deciding in view of the exceptional rain, to close the Theatre for the evening.

A Visitor Honoured.
Dr. Mayo Robson's Speech.
THE HOSPITAL QUESTION.

On Tuesday evening last all the members of the medical profession in the Nairobi district were invited to a banquet at the Hotel Robson, C. V. O. F. & C. S., who has recently been opened at a hospital here where he had been treated for a serious personal ailment. He received an ovation.

The dinner was held in the Durban Hotel, Dr. Mayo, the P.M.O., presided.

Dr. Mayo, in his address, said that the president proposed our honours guests in a graceful language.

Mr. Mayo Robson after a return of compliments and many pleasantries said: "I have spent a large part of the last 20 years of my life in the Hospital here, and I have made but little progress in my work and all connected with it. In looking into the very near future I foresee that in 10 years will be wholly composed of the officials of this Protectorate, who are rapidly increasing in numbers and for whom this hospital was entirely intended. "If when I return to my England I hear that one of the three millions to be allocated to the Medical Department of this country, I shall be very disappointed and shall be compelled to think that those who were ignorant of first principles. I understand when one is sometimes called to a distance from Nairobi the medical man not only receives a fee for his scientific advice, but he is actually to pay for the motor car.

"In this country there are a number of considerable means at home and elsewhere which are not being put to use. 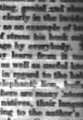

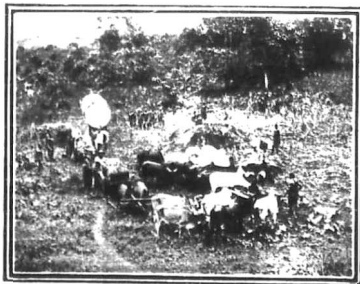

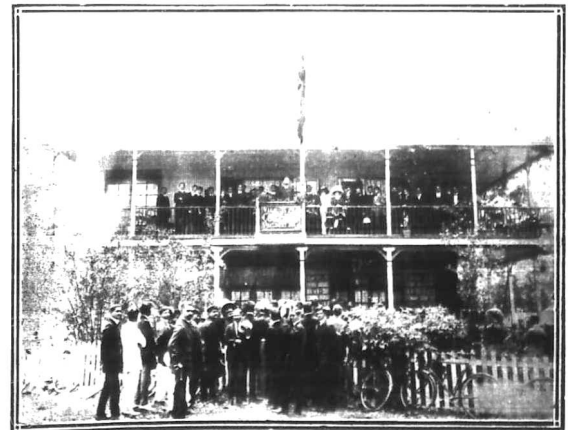
