## Great Battle of Haelen. Operations in Belgium.

GERMANS REPULSED.

Liege Forts Intact.

[THROUCH BRETHER'S AGENCY.]

London, Thursday.

A Belgian announcement says that, after retreating on August 11, the Germans resumed the advance yesterday.

The Belgians fought their first engagement in the open to the north-west of Haelen, successfully holding their own. Ten thousand troops participated.

The Germans are constructing siege batteries to the north of Liege.

It is reported that the forts of Liege are still intact.

Yesterday's engagement will be known as the Battle of Haelen, it lasted throughout the day, by the evening the Belgians had entirely cleared the ground between Diest, Haelen and Zellich.

After the battle the country was covered with dead; for a time a portion of the Belgian left wing was retired but was reinforced.

A Belgian official despatch confesses the victory of Haelen. The German losses were three-fifths of those engaged.

A Dutch report to the "Daily Mail" says that the Germans captured Diest while advancing towards Antwerp.

"The Germans do not appear to be in great force before us. Our army is not in direct contact with the enemy; but any and generally there seems to be a temporary lull."

Commanding was issued at Tielmont at three o'clock on Saturday afternoon, the sound coming from the direction of the neighbouring villages of Hael and Hoorwacht. This is believed to be the beginning of a great battle.

A communique issued by the French Government preparing the public for the impending great battle, says that owing to the fact that several millions of men will be engaged on a front extending 250 miles no definite result can be expected for a week or more. The communique appeals to the public to follow the phases of the operations coolly and intelligently.

It is officially stated that the French broke the offensive in force on Friday night along the line of Saarburg and Lunelville. The movement was successfully continued on Saturday.

A number of Germans, fleeing before the French attack at Dinant, failed to reach the bridge, when they fell into the deep banks of the Meuse and were drowned. A French cavalry regiment pursued the enemy for several kilometres.

The success at Dinant was followed by the French cavalry repulsing the German army on the right bank of the Meuse.

London, Tuesday.

The Belgian royal family, except the King who is with the army, the Government (to a partial extent) and the legations have moved to Brussels. Last night, the army set out towards the east to defend Brussels against a sudden cavalry raid.

The Germans, during the last few days, have been entreaching themselves along the Belgian battle-front.

As officially announced in Brussels, it appears that every raid on Brussels has been frustrated. The German covenant north of Brussels is apparently a feint.

Official French despatches state that all the forces at Liege are still holding out.

The Germans are retreating across the Meuse river near Dinant having been repulsed with considerable loss by French artillery.

Brussels, Tuesday.

A fierce battle is now in progress between the Belgian and German forces along the Tielmont.

Brussels, Wednesday.

The Germans again attacked Diest yesterday afternoon, in force. They pillaged the railway station and bombarded the town, from which the terrified inhabitants are fleeing. They are also reported to have bombarded Tielmont yesterday. The German advance guard quietly pushed forward to the neighbourhood of the Belgian positions. An aviator, however, detected the movement, and averted a possible surprise by warning headquarters.

Very large German forces are crossing the Meuse between Liege and Namur.

London, Thursday.

Brussels despatches confirm the advance of Belgian and French forces along the line. Two divisions of French cavalry have been coöperating one hundred kilometres daily.

It is officially stated that all the Liege forts are intact.

## Fighting in Alsace. ADVANCE ON STRASSBURG. Continued French Successes.

SERIOUS GERMAN LOSSES.

[THROUCH BRETHER'S AGENCY.]

London, Friday.

The French defeated and pursued the Germans after a two-days' battle at the River Odenk south of Strasbourg. A regiment of dragoons was annihilated and the French captured a thousand officers and men.

London, Saturday.

France maintains possession of the crest of the Vosges, repulsing well-directed German attacks.

The French captured at Althain a battery of artillery and three mitrailleuses with ammunition wagons.

London, Sunday.

An official Paris despatch says the French forces drove a German army corps from the heights commanding Bismont and Grey, back on Saarburg, after a hot engagement. The Germans suffered serious losses, including a number of prisoners.

At Grey, south of Bismont, the German enemy, defeated by the French were put to flight leaving many dead, wounded, and prisoners.

The French continue to advance in the province of Vosges and upper Alsace, where they have recaptured Thun.

In the fighting at Vosges yesterday and the day before, the French took 1,000 prisoners and several big guns.

The French forces brilliantly defeated a Bavarian army corps at Arrécourt.

London, Monday.

French troops are advancing all along Alsace-Lorraine. The movement was particularly rapid towards Strasbourg where they captured many heavy-calibre guns, a field-gun and conveyances including motor lorries.

French troops are making methodical progress in Alsace-Lorraine. They have gained a distance of some ten to twenty kilometres all along the frontier from Chambrey, to Belfort, and are advancing strongly in the valleys, particularly on Strasbourg.

London, Wednesday.

An official Paris communique says the French advanced rapidly to the afternoon and reached Moerschingen, south-east of Metz, on the important Metz-Strasbourg railway.

KING'S MESSAGE TO TROOPS.

[THROUCH BRETHER'S AGENCY.]

London, Friday.

The Bank of England returns show a Reserve of 151 millions, public deposits, eight millions, other deposits 851 millions, and other securities 701 millions, showing a proportion of 11 per cent.

Earl Roberts has been appointed Colonel in Chief of the Forces from overseas.

London, Saturday.

The Bank of England had during the past week a gold influx of 24 millions.

The Prince of Wales' fund has reached a million pounds.

The official Press Bureau warns the British public against rumours of the arrival of wounded men by disabled ships in Great Britain which, without exception, are baseless. It says the successes and reverses of British arms will be announced officially from time to time.

London, Tuesday.

Gen. Smith Dorrien will command the army corps of the expeditionary force, in addition to Gen. Buller.

Prince Alexander of Teck is going on a five days' visit.

The Press Bureau announces that the expeditionary force, as detailed for foreign service, have been safely landed on French soil. The embarkation, transportation and disembarkation of the men and stores were all carried out with the greatest precision and without a single casualty.

The King in a message to the troops in the expeditionary force said: "You are leaving home to fight for the safety and honour of my Empire. Belgium, a country which has been pledged to defend herself against France is about to be invaded by the same foe. I have implicit confidence in you. My prayers, duty will be your watchword and your duty will be noble done. I shall follow every movement with deepest interest and mark with eager satisfaction every step which you will take. I shall be proud to be proud of my thoughts. I pray God to bless you, guard you and bring you home victorious."

Earl Kitchener has issued instructions that every expeditionary soldier is to keep in his pay-book.

In an address to the troops he says: "You are ordered abroad as soldiers of the King to help our French comrades to repress invasions of their country by our common enemy. You have to perform a task needing your courage, your energy and your patience. Remember that the honour will fall on the most part takes place in a friendly country. You can do your own country no better service than by showing your loyalty to France and Belgium in the discharge of a British soldier. Be invariably courteous, considerate and kind. Never do anything likely to injure or destroy property. Always look upon looking as a disgraceful act. You are sure to be welcomed and welcomed; your conduct must justify that trust. You desire to be respected, but not to be despised, your health is sound, as long as you are with your own men and your own women. Both temptations you must entirely resist, and while treating all women with perfect courtesy, you must be careful not to be seen to be especially favoured by God and honour the King."

London, Friday.

Tokio, Sunday.

Japan has sent an ultimatum to Germany, saying that, in order to prevent a disturbance in the Far East, as contemplated by the British alliance, Japan advised Germany to withdraw or disarm all armed vessels in Japanese or Chinese waters, and deliver Kiao-Chau to Japan with a view to its eventual restoration to China. Japan refused to answer by noon on August 22. If the advice is not accepted unconditionally, Japan will take necessary steps.

London, Monday.

The Japanese Ambassador has informed the United States that every American vessel will be regarded as an enemy. The United States regard the Japanese practice to restore Kiao-Chau to China as satisfactory.

Great silence prevails in the main war theatres. Only scrap of news are filtering through.

Liege is still intact after five days' fighting.

Belgium has asked France to accommodate 2,000 German prisoners.

The Belgian Government states that no further communications will be issued regarding the movements of Belgian and French troops.

The Press Bureau announces that the Belgians have driven the enemy eastwards, but there are no German cavalry between Haelen and Namur.

The forts at Liege are plentifully supplied. The Germans are concealing their attack on those of the Liege forts which are on the right bank of the Meuse.

The Belgian newspaper announces that the transportation of French troops to Belgian territory is complete. The whole force is ready to advance.

The smallest of the area of operations in Belgium and the nearest to Brussels particularly necessitate the present silence.

The report that Germans are marching on Antwerp is absolutely denied in Brussels.

The Belgian head-quarters announces that no fighting took place yesterday. Long Belgian communications failed to discover the enemy's forces. It is believed that they have retired on the main body.

The Germans are concentrating for an attack on the Liege forts on the left, not on the right bank of the Meuse.

The French Ministry of War announces that French troops have entered Belgium at Charleroi, and are advancing on Ganshuro in force.

The Press Bureau announces that there are indications of the German forces on the Allied forces. There have been one or two engagements but these are mainly outpost affairs.

London, Monday.

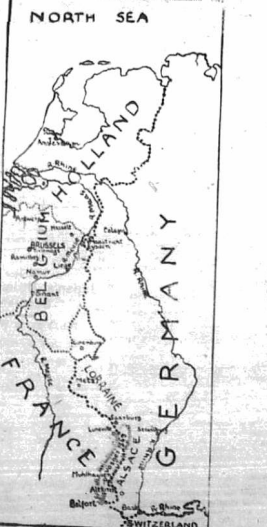

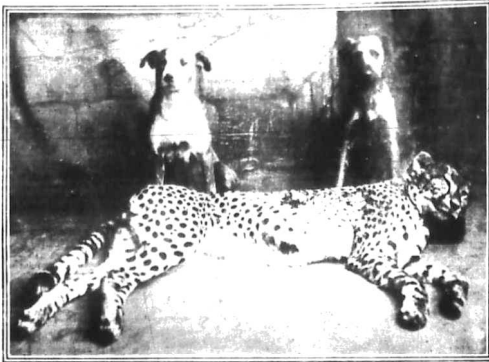

Amidst cheers Mr. Asquith rose in the House of Commons and moved the following resolution:—That an irreducible address be presented to His Majesty the King praying him to convey to His Majesty the King of the Belgians the sympathy and admiration with which this House regards the heroic resistance offered by his army and his people to the wicked invasion into his territory and to convey an assurance of the determination of this country to support in every way the efforts of Belgium to vindicate her own independence and the public law of Europe.

Mr. Asquith, continuing, said, "Very few words are needed to commend to the House the terms of this address."

The war which is now shaking to its foundation the whole system of Europe originated in a quarrel in which this country had no direct concern. We strove with all our might as everyone now knows, "cheers" to prevent its outbreak, and when that was no longer possible, to limit its area. It is so important that it should be clearly understood when it was and why it was we intervened.

It was only when we were confronted with the choice between helping and breaking our solemn obligations to the discharge of a leading trust and a shameless subservience to a small State, that we have the smallest shadow of a doubt as to what we should do. We do not regret our decision (great cheer). The issue was one which no great and self-respecting nation, certainly not one that had and retained the supremacy in this continent since the days of the great Duke, could have hesitated to take. (Cheers.)

Considering the Premier said we were bound by obligations which were not only plain but paramount to assist and maintain the threatened independence of a small and weak State. Belgium had no interests of her own to serve, (cheers) save and except the support and assisting interest of every State, great or little which is worthy of the name. That is to say, the preservation of the Empire and her nationality. (Cheers.) History tells us that the treaty of Commerce which gave independence to the traffic on the Dnieper river. well (they beat high is nearly perfect, and inside a labyrinth of passages and cast-iron, and one or two covered gateways or passages, a service passage, and a passage, for instance, in a little downy chamber by a cutting line of steps, the line leads to the water on either hand. It is obvious that these ruins have been situated by the department of their original builders for the circular cement floors of Malakasia, later now pleasantly superadded. The buildings are only seen partial, and much that is interesting has probably still to be discovered. No general writing has been discovered by any of the ruins, but relics of various kinds point to more than their original use. Old beads and rough chains, implements of flint, and others of doubtful date are the chief finds, but the most interesting experience are the exquisite mosaics, some plain, some carved at the top with birds, and one, at all events, with a most interesting design of a crocodile, with a monkey, and another, with a crocodile and a bird. These are found in considerable numbers and seem generally to have been placed on the heads of the basins. They are of stone and are the work of the temple wall, round in the middle which forms the center, meeting at different angles, and on various parts of the fortress they are also placed like step-pedestal-walves, volutes in the shape of a fungus, just from "United Empire."
