TAKING OF KEETMAN-SHOOP.

General Buxton telegraphed the following report on April 29 from Keetmanshoop...

"After my arrival at Colonel van der Venster's headquarters at Keetmanshoop on April 31 a plan of operations was discussed and held a meeting of the principal officers...

"The enemy was well hidden and escaped so rapidly, as to prevent his concentration on any particular portion of our column...

"Colonel Clarke, with a portion of his Fourth Brigade, consisting of the Transvaal Active Citizens Force, was ordered to take the western route along the railway line from Keetmanshoop to Swakop.

"The enemy, mistaking these movements for the main body of Colonel Collins' column, immediately retreated towards the north-east...

"The British maintained their position until Colonel Collins' main force arrived in Swakop on the 29th. Mounted Rifles and another portion of the Transvaal Active Citizens Force on the 29th Mounted Rifles from the Cape, was working his way round the eastern slope of the Keetmanshoop hills...

"On Monday a rapid movement was made with the object of cutting off the enemy's retreat from Keetmanshoop, but this morning it was found that the enemy had left his night by road and rail for the north."

"The distance from Keetmanshoop to Keetmanshoop is 12 1/2 miles over country of a most difficult character, and the endurance of the troops and the rapidity of the movement, considering the nature of the route and the destruction of all means of watering the animals, deserve very high commendation."

"An occasion has been unfavorable for telegraphic communication, great difficulty has been experienced in maintaining communication with the forces under Colonel Buxton's command, the S.A.M.C. advancing from Swakop to Keetmanshoop. From some fragmentary messages which have come through it appears that the force which consists of the 9th Regiment of the S.A.M.C., the Kalahari Horse, Oulliman's Horse, and the 10th or 11th Mounted Rifles, has been constantly engaged with the enemy."

"The enemy's aerostatic capabilities require one officer and three men killed, one wounded and one officer and seven men killed."

"The loss of our aerostats which occurred on the 13th instant is the engagement at Kiries Court, in which our advanced patrols only were engaged, were one killed, one wounded, two captured and two missing, one of the Kalahari Horse."

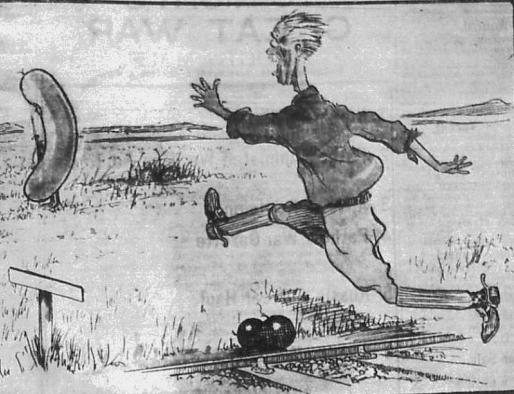
