ALTERATIONS IN FRENCH MILITARY SERVICE.

March 5. The French Chamber by 314 against 174 has agreed to reduce the term of enlistment for reservists and territorial troops to 18 months.

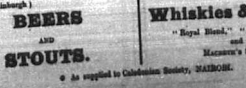

the freedom of all those who had been slaves prior to the passing of the Act and three days before he died, the news was brought to him that the British Government had purchased the freedom of the West Indian slaves.

Slave dealing, was carried on in our midst in this connection for sixteen years ago and though in that year both Great Britain and Germany had entered solemnly into a treaty to stop to the practice they found it very difficult owing to the wretchedness of the Arabs and the cleverness of the negroes and the slave-dealers.

It is common knowledge to those who have recently visited the interior villages and coastal townspeople that both slave wars and the slave trade have never looked upon European intervention in the light of an injustice to them both and to this very many of the world who are living a contented existence of the same character as they lived before slave trading was abolished in East Africa.

It is only necessary to read the authentic histories of the late infamously Tippu Tib and his confederates that so long ago in India, to see how committed by these leaders of slave raiding bands existed, the country could not hope to prosper.

In discussing the Emancipation Act with the late Sir John Lubbock and relating his arguments as to the right of slave owning the writer had the great difficulty in making his point that the native slave trader had been treated and the way in which he had been carried from his home far expeditions it was only a matter of time before a quarter of a mile from his own threshold and showed him the remains of a slave and the bones of a man regularly made by the Arabs who raided the Congo and even the far reaches of the Nile for slaves, that he was influenced to do so.
