HELL IN A CHATEAU.

When giving some few weeks ago (write H. P. Prevost Batey) in the "Daily Bulletin" an account of that ghastly and bloody day, fighting which ended in the capture of Vermelles by the French, great interest was expressed that the German account at first, or even at authentic second hand could be obtained. The ground between the German line rose slightly for the first 800 yards, then dipped and ended in a very steep slope towards the German position, which commanded the whole line of advance. By force of description, sharp, machine-guns, shells, and last, but not least, high explosive shells, with supporting guns—the numerous nature of the force can be gauged by the fact that, when the bottom of the trench was reached, at a point some 500 yards from the start, the commanding officer (Major Williams) had been wounded, also Captain Bradford had been killed, and had been known of by an assisting staff. Captain Mallon had been killed, but he, like the others, was not killed, but he refused to report himself wounded, and was on the final line of attack. In the face of these losses the attack was pressed to a point about 80 yards from the German trench, and there, after a short rest, the attack was renewed. Captain Mackay, and Captain Banks, of the Indian Infantry, attached to the regiment, were all killed, and two Indian officers, and four Indian N.C.O.s were wounded.
