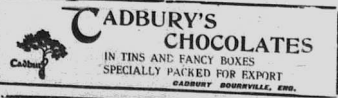

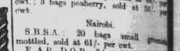

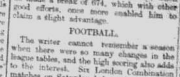

WAR AND DIPLOMACY.

A FEW OF OUR FOREIGN OFFICE FAILINGS.

(BY EDGAR WALLACE.)

London, January 7. Three months have passed since I declared our Turkey and quite a considerable time has elapsed for the purpose of our reviewing the Turkish situation.
