The Agency's Rome correspondent states that during the debate in the Chamber on the Foreign Estimates, Baron Sonnino, Minister of Foreign Affairs, in recognizing the part Italy had played in the war, said that, thanks to the cooperation of the Italian and Allied navies, thousands of tons of stores had been sent to Albania and 25,000 Serbian and 10,000 hours had been transported across the sea with very small losses, in spite of numerous attacks.

The battle of Verdun constituted a remarkable success to the French army because the enemy had been driven back to the military supremacy. "They were very tremendously on Verdun," said the Kaiser, "and I would like to know how that the German people had made such a great sacrifice."

An extraordinary news followed Baron Sonnino's speech. Signor Cappa, a Republican Deputy who had previously supported the Government, declared that at the present moment he should give way to the necessity of union for victory.
