THE G.E.A. CAMPAIGN. PHASES OF THE FIGHTING. German Natives' Horrible Plight. GHOSTLY LOT OF THE PORTERS.

The following cables were sent out by Mr. Ver Stent, Reader's special correspondent at advanced German Headquarters, German East Africa, between June 1st and June 20th:-

SWEETENING SOUTH. AT KONDOIA TRANGE. The camp fires of German Scouts are sweeping south, the blaze extending from the snow-hatched Pangani to the hills of the Pare Mountains.

POSTERING NATIVE GOODWILL. The very greatest care has been taken over receipts, settling payment, for all debts and food commodities, to the satisfaction of the natives, who trade freely in low and eggs.

SMUTS CASTS HIS NET. General Smuts, retreating, has found himself once more, this time about Hamu, 100 miles due west of the month of Pangani, on the old slave and caravan route from Pangani to Kondonia Trange.

PARÉ MOUNTAIN CLEARED. Union Day sees the accomplishment of another task—the Pare Mountains are clear. We are to have the German Mountains. The lights of Wilhelmstadt are visible.

In extension of the power conferred by the Motor Traffic Bill, 1913, section 15 (iv), His Excellency the Governor in Council has been pleased to make the following rules—
