WESTERN FRONT.

Fierce Fighting in Artois.

MUTUAL BOMBARDMENTS ALONG WHOLE FRONT.

Enemy's Frenzied Attacks Repulsed.

GERMAN COMPANY SURROUNDED AND DECIMATED.

(REUTERS BROTHER'S AGENCY.)

London, February 18. This communique reports some local fighting in Artois. We occupied more of La Felle. The Germans at night launched a strong attack between La Felle and La Felle road, but were repulsed. We took some prisoners in the new line and also two quickfuzes.

London, February 11. This communique reports that we continue progress in Artois by bombing ammunition trenches west of the Yser canal. We repulsed attacks to the west. Hill 160 was completely repulsed. The Germans exploded a mine north of the Bellefleur road and we occupied the rest of the trench. The enemy attempted to break through the Somme, but was unsuccessful. Our artillery destroyed trenches in the Boisvignes district between enemy positions and the Yser canal. We captured a machine gun and a mortar in the Yser canal. The Germans threw three heavy shells at long range on the fortress of Belfort, but only one fell when our artillery concentrated fire on the enemy battery which had been located on the February 9th. We bombarded the military hospital south-west of Mulhouse.

This communique says there is no smoking in the trenches.

Early to-day, the enemy broke into our trenches near Pilken, but were driven out by bombing parties, leaving some dead and wounded.

There has been some mining activity about Hilluch, to the north of Ypres and along the German Canal.

A Paris communique dealing with the operations in Belgium says that after a violent artillery preparation the Germans made several attempts to cross the Yser canal opposite Steenstraete and Heusen. The attempts were crushed by our combined artillery and machine gun fire.

In Champagne, the struggle has been most active. Near Meul and the Narvaux Hills, the enemy, after several hours' bombardment, succeeded in penetrating a small salient on our line between the Narvaux-Saint-Sulpice roads.

The Germans to the north-east of Meul Hill again counter-attacked, endeavoring to expel us from the trenches we occupied yesterday, but they were repulsed. We continued to progress, by bombing, to the east of these trenches, taking prisoners.

An enemy attack in the Vosges, to the east of Sainville, failed to reach our first line.

London, February 13.

A Paris communique contains the information that the French guns, to the north of Vier-sur-Aisne, dispersed German detachments which had advanced as far as our entanglements.

The Germans in the neighbourhood of Crony, reached the French trenches, but a counter-attack promptly drove them out. The Germans left their dead and prisoners.

The enemy in Champagne, launched five successive counter-attacks upon the Bellefleur road during the day, and in the evening. All were repulsed.

Artillery activity has occurred in Lorraine.

our artillery rendered abortive the infantry attacks which were preparing. We took some prisoners in the Champagne fight.

The enemy gained a footing in our advanced trenches to the east of Tabure. An enemy attack in Upper Alsace was crushed by our artillery.

A Paris communique says that, to the south of the Somme, the French made an attack at dusk on the German works near Frise. They occupied some portions of the German trenches. The enemy, when driven by a counter-attack, was mown down by the French fire.

We surrounded a German company and decimated it. A captain and 70 survivors surrendered.

We also took other prisoners and a number of machine-guns. The number of the enemy's dead was considerable.

In Champagne, in the course of a German attack to the east of the Thure-Sumery road, we exploded three mines under the enemy in our advanced elements. His attempts to advance to our support trenches failed completely, but, notwithstanding the serious German losses by mine and artillery, the Germans remained in the advanced elements.

A furious artillery battle has occurred in Alsace. The Germans took 200 yards of our trench, but an immediate counter-attack regained most of the ground.

[OFFICIAL.]

London, February 14. There has been considerable fighting in France during the last week. The French have taken a notable portion of trenches captured by the enemy to the south of Frise; counter-attacks were repulsed.

West of Vincy, the enemy penetrated some sectors of a French trench, but were afterwards driven out by a grenade attack.

We attacked 300 metres of enemy trenches, and captured Meul Ridge in Champagne. All counter-attacks were defeated.

The enemy also attacked unsuccessfully on the Yser canal, and to the north-east of Soissons.

The enemy penetrated the British lines near Pilken, but were driven out by a bombing attack.

London, February 15. The enemy has been very active in carrying out mining work to the south of the Le Basse canal. He exploded seven mines in 24 hours.

To the south of Fosse 8, there were also mine explosions, which were preceded by a heavy bombardment, and followed by a small infantry attack. A few men entered our front trench, but were immediately expelled by hand grenades.

A British communique says that there were 17 air fights yesterday. One large hostile double-engine machine was driven down in the enemy's lines.

German wireless reports that 40 British prisoners were captured during the fighting at Pillon. It is pointed out, in reply to the assertion, that we had 11 missing in this fighting, of which eight are believed to have been killed. These men were lost whilst pursuing the Germans back to their trenches.

A Paris communique says that our artillery in Belgium blew up a munitions depot to the north of Bouvignies.

The enemy infantry yesterday evening, to the north of Soissons, after a heavy bombardment, attempted to debouch. They were stopped immediately by our artillery and rifle fire.

Several infantry fighting has occurred in Champagne.

The enemy, in Upper Alsace, heavily bombarded our advanced trenches to the east of Sappigny, which we had captured at night, but we had evacuated the positions which were entirely wrecked.

Our artillery in the same region shelled enemy reinforcements which were attempting to advance in small parties.

A Paris communique says that the French have captured part of the advanced elements in Tabure.

London, February 16. A communique states that after a heavy bombardment of the whole front at Ypres, and a salient to the south of Heuse, the enemy made several infantry attacks, and

broke into our front trench on a front of 600 yards between the Ypres-Commines canal and the Ypres-Commines railway. All other attacks failed.

The heavy bombardments on both sides continue.

A Paris communique contains the information that the day has been relatively quiet.

Our trench guns in Artois bombarded the enemy positions in the vicinity of the Lille road.

The batteries to the west of the Oise bombarded a train and a supply convoy in the station of Epigny, to the north of Vier-sur-Aisne.

A destructive bombardment of the German works to the north-east of Soissons has occurred.

We exploded a mine at Pille-Morte in the Argonne, occupying the crater.

Our artillery in Upper Alsace shelled the German position to the east of Sappigny all day.

A Paris communique says that we recaptured more ground at Abbe.

RECENT AIR RAID.

Official Report.

London, February 10. The official report of the air raid on February 9 says that the raiders selected a narrow field of women and children as a target, but a bomb fell without doing damage and there was no panic. The raiders were plainly seen circling round and dropped three bombs in an adjoining field.

A second raider selected a large girls' school, where a bomb exploded in the upper story. Some material damage was done to a portion of the ceiling which fell on a class of small children. A little girl had her foot cut and was slightly injured. Three bombs fell into the school ground without doing damage.

Two other bombs caused slight material damage and wounded a woman. Naval and military aeroplanes ascended within a few minutes of sighting the raiders, but they were unable to overtake the enemy owing to the precipitate nature of the flight.

FRENCH CRUISER LOST.

Rumour Confirmed.

London, February 13. A Paris naval communique says that some unconfirmed reports in regard to the 4,000 ton auxiliary cruiser "Amiral Charner," which has been missing since February 8, when a German submarine claimed to have sunk a French cruiser.

London, February 14. A Paris message says that the loss of the cruiser "Amiral Charner" is confirmed.

A raid was picked up off the coast of Syria, bearing 15 seamen. Only one was alive, who said that the cruiser was torpedoed on February 8, and sank in a few minutes. It was impossible to launch the boats.

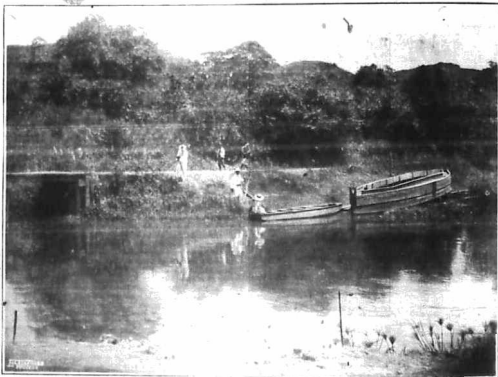

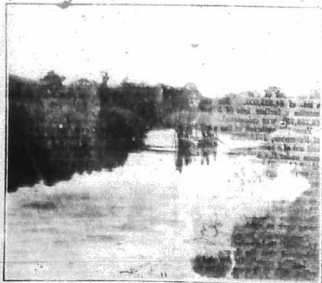
