WESTERN FRONT.

Great Fight to North of Verdun.

BATTLE SWAYING TO AND FRO.

Slopes Covered with German Dead.

FRENCH POSITION FAVOURABLE.

[THROUGH BERTIN'S AGENCY.]

London, February 24.

A Paris communique says that, to the west of Verdun, fighting has continued throughout the night with the same intensity from the right bank of the Meuse to the south of Ornes.

In consequence of the violence of the bombardment of our advanced positions at Mont-sur-Meuse, we evacuated the lines under cover of darkness, and under the shelter of our batteries on the left bank of the Meuse.

A German attack against Seminegny was repulsed, and a German brigade repulsed the Bois des Carres, recapturing part of the wood, of which we hold the main object.

All offensive movements against Douaumont failed to discharge us.

We demolish the ravine to the south of Douaumont.

The attacking movements, which were intended for the purpose of the prevention of our losses, were carried out in perfect order.

To Germans who advanced only with speed, and at the cost of heavy sacrifices, we made to break our front at any point.

There has been a continuous bombardment between Ornes and Fromeville.

The Germans in Lorraine gained a footing at an advanced post, but were immediately repulsed.

French aeroplane squadrons dropped heavy bombs upon Metzrath station and the works there. A great fire was extinguished.

The struggle is swaying to and fro, the result of Verdun.

The chief French critics say that it is not yet a question of holding mathematically any yard of ground, but rather of the Germans suffer the maximum of losses.

The communique is most brief, but it is clear that the German troops captured villages of Beudant, Haumont, and the west of the Wood district in the neighbourhood of Verdun.

On the other hand, the communique states that the sanguinary losses of the enemy were extraordinarily heavy, while those of the Germans were normal.

It also states a total of 10,000 prisoners for the whole front.

Bertin's correspondent in Paris says that the Germans made a great four days attack to the north of Verdun. It is as yet uncertain as to the exact magnitude of the German losses, and consequently the most minute precautions must be taken.

It is significant that an order by the German General, Demling, which has been published, demanding that the famous fifteenth corps, "in the course of its last offensive against the French, to display its courage and prowess."

Other indications show that the Germans hoped for a speedy and decisive victory.

A later Paris communique contains the announcement that, to the north of Verdun, the cannonade has continued, but with less violence.

The Germans made no attack in the course of the night.

We again established on an organized line of resistance behind Douaumont, and on the heights to the east of Champ Neuville to the south of Ornes.

Field-Marshal Sir Douglas Haig reports that our airplanes successfully threw bombs on the enemy aerodrome near Lille.

All the machine guns were silent.

The British artillery has been active against enemy trenches round about the Ypres-Comines canal, and also to the east of Boesinghe.

London, February 20.

A Paris communique says that to the north of Verdun, a heavy snowfall has occurred.

The artillery activity on both sides has continued in a most intense fashion along the whole front, and especially along the Meuse, where the fighting has not diminished in desperation.

During the night there has been no change on the attacking front.

To the east of the Meuse, where a heavy snowfall has occurred, no fresh attempt has been reported either on Tahn hill or Poirve hill.

A dawn yesterday, a strong German attack was launched in the region of the farm at Haumont to the east of Poirve hill. This was broken up by our artillery and machine-gun fire, and counter-attacks.

Another German attempt, just as violent, was delivered at Bois Haumont. This met with no greater success.

The orderly retreat of our advanced posts in the Woivre was carried out without the least molestation by the enemy.

There has been no infantry action to the west of the Meuse.

The Germans, in the Woivre, after an artillery preparation, attempted a strong attack at nightfall from two kilometres to the south-east of Colles. It completely failed.

An action by our batteries to-day against the supply stores at Stoueville and to the north of Munster gave good results.

A British communique says that last night we repulsed a small attack to the north of Ypres-Comines canal.

To-day the Germans have been mutually active about Hullych, Armentieres and Ypres.

North of Verdun, the increasing bombing continues.

To the east of Werb and the Meuse, the French are replying to all attacks by vigorous counter-attacks.

All fresh attacks by the Germans in the region of Champneuville and Poirve hill, which are so solidly established, have been repulsed.

A desperate struggle is raging round the Douaumont fort, which is the advanced element of the old defensive organization of the Verdun fortress.

We again reached and passed beyond the position which the Germans captured in the morning after several fruitless and very costly assaults. All the enemy attempts to force us back failed.

Our heavy artillery bombarded the bunkers and depots to the north-west of St. Mihael.

The Germans sent several heavy shells to the direction of Louvain and Nancy.

There has been an artillery duel at Hartmannswiller and in the Woivre.

We shelled an enemy detachment in the Second position, and caused out a destructive fire against the enemy works between Soissons and Reims.

A Paris communique says that, to the north of Verdun, the bombardment has continued in the same intense fashion. This has been especially so in the central sector and towards the right.

There has been no fresh attempt at Poirve Hill, but at least the Germans made several attempts to carry the village of Douaumont.

Their efforts, however, broke against the resistance of our troops, who were unshakable in the face of the most furious assault.

The situation remains unchanged at Poirve Douaumont, which remains closely surrounded.

Fighting has been less furious on the plateau to the east of Douaumont.

The Germans were more active in the Woivre yesterday evening.

The railway station at Ris was taken and retaken, but remains in our possession.

All attempts to drive our troops from Hill 103 to the south-east of Eix, failed.

A German attack further to the south against Metzrath failed completely.

Our artillery is energetically repelling the enemy's bombardment along the entire front as a whole.

We bombarded several enemy cantonments in the Woivre, and also the German organizations at Stoueville.

A German coup de main succeeded in penetrating some of our elements in an advanced trench at the north of Navarin farm in Champagne.

The bombardments along the entire western front show the vastness of the German offensive.

The small thrust in Champagne may be followed by others.

A Berlin communique claims a gain of five or 1,000 yards at Navarin, 1,000 prisoners, nine machine guns, and one mortar.

Under our fire the Germans in the Woivre position are in a state of confusion.

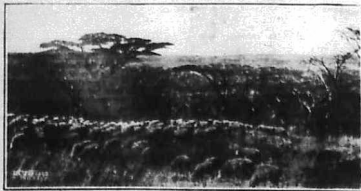

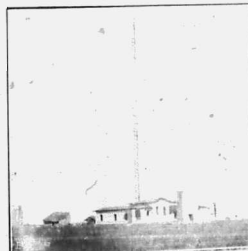
