The list of those killed in the factory includes the following: Sergeant Major, and the military attaché was not seen after the explosion, and it is not known whether he was seriously injured. About 100 persons are reported to have been seriously injured.

The Local Government Board and the War Office have been asked to supply the funds which have been raised on behalf of the victims. Meanwhile the Ministry of Munitions has requested the borough authorities to provide relief.

The Ministry of Munitions has stated that the method taken has practical difficulties, and the Minister today. Every effort will be being made to deal with the immediate needs of the explosion.

A French communiqué reports about the damage and loss of life, and expressed his regret that the facilities at the factory had not been improved.

As a result of the explosion, all the munitions in the hospital, probably, therefore, the death toll of the explosion was between 20 and 30. In patients near 112, which in addition, 300 persons who were slightly injured, have been treated.

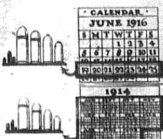

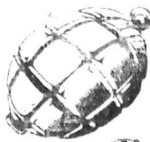
