CROSS-PURPOSES

Collection of Intellectuals Wanted.

Mr. Harry Johnson, writing in the "Westminster Gazette" on "Cross Purposes, recollects:—There surely never was more inclined to explain in the contrary, the coexistence of nearly all systems of public opinion, the cross-purposes of would-be reformers, the functions of would-be conservatives, the language in the mouths of rhetoricians, the reserves of Liberal statesmen, the conservatism of Liberal leaders, and the impudence of radicals.

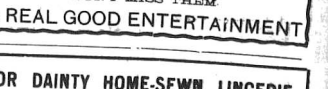

The Lake Road—Beyond the western boundary of the Highland Zone, the country descends to a level of between 4,000 and 5,000 feet, the climate being warm and humid and the vegetation a decidedly tropical nature.

The soil of a large portion of this area is that commonly known as cotton soil and capable of producing very heavy crops. The area is mostly covered with forest during recent years. Owing to the frequent landslides in portions of the Province (as mentioned in the Nyassa Province very extensive developments taking place, the chief products raised being, maize, sugar, cotton, rice, sorghum (including the white, yellow, and red varieties), coffee, tea, rubber, sugar-cane, groundnuts, and bananas, and in one particular tract, the orange, and also a very profitable industry. Further, cattle pasturing—the process of *East Coast fever* not rampant so well and large quantities of glass are produced and exported to the natives.

**MANURES ON SOUTH ZONE.**—To the north of the zone already referred to is a very large tract of country (to extent about one half of the Protectorate) occupied in part by natives and in part by whites, and is well adapted for agricultural or pastoral development, but from time to time it has been the theatre of outbreaks of *East Coast fever*, the result of which is a semi-arid character without trees, excepting the *Acacia* growing through it which could be utilized for irrigation.

On the other hand, and granted a large tract, the *East Nyasa* zone, which lies to the North East, the East in the Middle, and the South in the Coast zone respectively, could be utilized for providing irrigation on a very extensive scale for the culture of sugarcane, and other crops.

Examining the South East Zone, of which there is very little, it is found that agricultural or pastoral development is not looked upon as an agricultural proposition, the main reason being that the country comprises an area of 75,000 acres. Of this it is estimated that 1,750,000 acres are at present under cultivation and the balance is made up of pasture and bush.

The Lake Zone.—Beyond the western boundary of the Highland Zone, the topography is level, and the altitude varies between 4,000 and 5,000 feet, the climate being warm and humid and the vegetation is a decidedly tropical nature.

The soil of a large portion of the area is that commonly known as orange soil, capable of producing very heavy crops. The area is mostly under native ownership but during recent years owing to the interest taken in agriculture by the Protector General of the Eastern Province very extensive agricultural settlements have taken place; the chief products raised being, maize, sun-dried beans, sugar, oranges, pineapples, guavas, mangoes, sugar-cane, ground nuts, chillies and bananas, and in some particular districts the presence of East European vegetable industries. Further, large quantities of fish are produced and disposed of by the lake.

The NATIBO or Sen-Ard Zone.—To the north of the zone already referred to lies a very large tract of country (the extent about one half of the Protectorate) composed in parts only by various patches of grassland. Little or no knowledge of this zone is available in respect to the suitability for white settlement or for agricultural or pastoral development, but from what has been ascertained I have reason to believe that most of it is of a semi-arid character without rivers, excepting the Lake Victoria through it which could be utilised for irrigation.

On the other hand, and granted a large lake in the East African zone, the Sen-Ard Zone, the Taia in the Midland, and the Makala in the Coast zones respectively, could be utilised for providing irrigation on a very extensive scale for the culture of sugar-cane, and other crops.

Enclosing the Sen-Ard Zone, there lies a very little strip of mainly agricultural or pastoral development which is not looked upon as an agricultural province; the remainder of the Protectorate comprises an area of 75,000,000 acres. Of this area the extent that is suitable for present under cultivation and the balance is made up of pasture and bush.

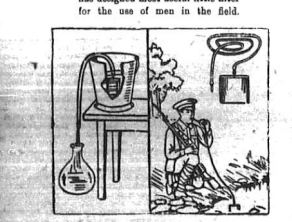
