LABOUR QUESTION. Sir—In your daily issue of Thursday last, dealing with the report of my evidence before the Economic Commission, you take me to task for providing the "impression of labour." As a matter of fact, nothing was further from my thoughts than thinking any such phrase in my mind. I merely because such a course would suit me in the eyes of the public. I am not a man of words but rather of the ground that the method of forced labour in the various provinces, and reactionary results are bound to bring fire down in their tracks. In my evidence I said that I entirely disclaimed approval of forced labour, which statement you have, in slightly altered wording, in your report.

The point which by my opinion should be made quite clear in dealing with the question of natives is that the influence of a white man over the native mind, especially in the new states, is a force which is not fully realized. That influence can be used either for the uplifting or for the debasement of the native. The means whereby a human being is improved or spoiled are many and varied. One may appeal to the ordinary sense—the desire for better food, his vanity for dress and ornaments, to his natural rapacity and love of possessions. Or one may appeal to something higher—the delight that comes with the driving of an automobile machine, the results of education, and the satisfaction that a man is a something higher than a brute beast. To all these the native is susceptible. Not only is he susceptible to the higher side of things but upon him by maintenance, officials and stations throughout the country. Immense influence could be given to these beneficial results very easily accomplished in the small details of life of this new world of things West, which is his common sense and a part of the higher nature improved status to which I have referred. All that depends on my knowledge, scope of my discharge commensurate with my position in the Government, and the results that there is a
