Standardisation of Bags

EFFORTS AT CO-ORDINATION BY KISUMU CHAMBER

Considerable interest is being developed by the Kisumu Chamber of Commerce in the problem of standardisation of bags for all produce and weights of bags to be used, and efforts are being made to bring about co-ordination.

THE CHAMBER'S VIEW

The following letter has been addressed by the secretary of the Kisumu Chamber to the agents of all shipping companies at the Coast:

Dear Sirs,—After correspondence between the Kisumu Chamber and a proposal made by this Chamber to standardise the principal produce in bulk, the Chamber, the principal Chamber in this respect, is now in receipt of the quality paper which has been prepared by the Chamber for each variety of produce, and which will greatly facilitate the handling of goods in bulk.

The Chamber feels that this proposal, if carried into effect, would be of great benefit to the shipping companies in particular.

If you are in favour of the proposal, will you please let us know so that we may be prepared to take in common with the other shipping companies, the necessary steps to be taken by the Chamber of Commerce generally, in both British and German Colonies.

The proposal of actual standardisation of produce is at present under the consideration of the various Chambers, but before proceeding further, the Chamber is desirous of ascertaining your views on this matter, which may be accepted, possibly, as far as export produce is concerned.

If you desire to be kept in touch with the Chamber for your support and cooperation, please advise G. HERRMANN, Secretary.

Kisumu, September 12. Messrs. Messrs. are also addressed to the Hon. H. Eastwood, General Manager of the Uganda Railway, and to the Hon. F. W. Mayer, C.M.G., I.C.S., Chief of Customs, asking for support of the proposal.

The latest Mr. Eastwood points out that the proposal would be of great benefit to the Uganda Railway, as it would facilitate the handling of goods in bulk, and stations is commended.

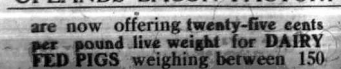
