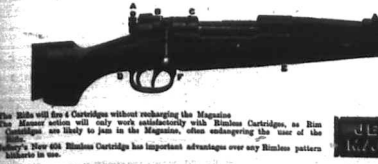

THE DIABLO AND ITS ACCESSORIES.

(Extracts from C. B. Fry's "Diablo".)

Just as a proper cricket ball is necessary for first-class cricket, so a good diabolo is necessary in order to play Diablo well.

M. Philippart has explained the amount of trouble and perseverance it costs him to produce the genuine diabolo—the sporting diabolo—which is made in Paris.

We have just spoken of the importance of the point has special importance.

The angle is too acute, the position of the insertion of the genuine diabolo is very difficult to catch; if the angle is almost as sharp as that on the string even in playing Diabolo and Raaf Diabolo.

When the angle and the material of the string are determined, the main point was the best weight. It is evident that the weights which are too heavy are too much for the player, and offer special difficulties in throwing in the air as well as in service in the ropes.

The cord must be of a definite thickness carefully selected to suit the exercise or practice which is being pursued. Thus in order to play Diabolo well, the cord must be longer than a great deal of what is known as the "best" Diabolo.

Everybody is aware that in a game of practice, the player's effort is not so much directed towards the attainment of the physical exercise, as in the case of the actual game.

In the exercises which we submit, the whole of our bodies are being taken up with the idea of weight or of length, and so on, our physical fatigue is comparatively slight.

We will now suggest the proper exercises which beginners ought to practice in order to save themselves time and trouble in becoming skilful diabolists.

The Diabolo and its Accessories.

(Extracts from C. H. Fry's "Diabolo.") Just as a proper cricket ball is necessary for first class cricket, so a good diabolo is necessary in order to play Diabolo well. It is to say, a diabolo the angles of which have been carefully calculated to suit the stable equilibrium, without which the game is not a game of skill. The Diabolo, invented and constructed by M. Traupner Philippart, the well known engineer of Paris, is now the only Diabolo in the world. M. Philippart has explained the amount of trouble and perseverance it cost him to produce the genuine Diabolo, the sporting Diabolo which is used to play an serious play. We have just seen of the angle made by the spinning of the two cones of the Diabolo. This point has special importance.

the angle is too acute, as is also the inclination of the general diabolo, the latter is very difficult to catch; if the angle is too obtuse, it is almost an impossibility to pass the string even in practice, which is quite impossible in playing Diabolo with the hand Diabolo. When the angle and the material used are determined, the main point to be considered is the weight. It is evident that the Diabolo which is too heavy cannot be managed and offer special inconvenience. Throwing in the air is possible as far as the Diabolo is concerned, but it is not possible to serve in the game. On the other hand, Diabolo that is too light become very light of the wind and their stability is not determined. The cord must be of a definite thickness, and it is not possible to vary it. It is necessary to show a great deal of skill. Some players, and by no means the least skillful, are inclined to exaggerate the use of the cord, with the idea of outwitting the attention of the spectators. This is a false view. Perhaps the best way to give a false view is to exaggerate, may be spoilt by instantly giving it a false view. But a cord that is too short, on the other hand, is certainly not good. It shows a lack of resources. There is a point to discover.

The Various Movements. A volume might be written on the physiology of the physical exercises suitable to training and Diabolo. Here we must content merely to give an outline of subject. Everybody is aware that in games of practice diminishes effort and increases effectiveness. In reality, and according to the opinion of most students of physiology, the brain exerts very largely in physical fatigue. The application of such muscular has a special effect upon our stamina and power of endurance. For example, a person who has been engaged in a strenuous expenditure in heart-beats without being shown any outward sign of fatigue, is certainly, since the action of the limbs and involuntary. In the exercises to which we subject our limbs and the whole of our bodies the sweating might occur. If our minds were taken up with the idea of weight or of fatigue, and so on, our physical fatigue would be comparatively slight. Therefore, in making a game of skill like Diabolo we ought to make up our minds - and it is not difficult to do so - that there is nothing whatever to be feared. It is necessary to acquire some of the secrets that are natural and involuntary in action of the hand. It will be necessary in taking up the preliminary practice exercises of the hand, to study the accuracy of method, and to aim at that one being the appointment of effort to result with a work of skill in all games.

We will now suggest the proper exercises which beginners ought to practice in order to save themselves time and trouble in becoming skillful diabolists. And it might be mentioned in passing, that people who are but moderately trained acquire sufficient accuracy of aim to find, after a few days practice that Diabolo corrects all their temporary imperfections.
