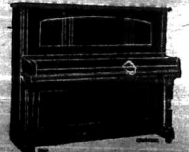

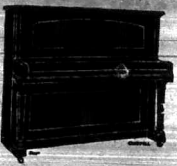

We regret to announce that another death has occurred at the Nairobi (Concentration Camp) Hospital, the deceased being the infant daughter of the late Mr. Hastings, who died from the disease at Thika.

The child was taken to the camp in a motor car, and was immediately taken to the hospital and the doctor in charge of the concentration camp, Mr. Hastings passing away soon after arrival there.
