PRIMAGE CHARGES

Motion at Chamber to Abolish Them.

"SIMPLY BLACK-MAIL."

The general meeting of the Nairobi Chamber of Commerce...

"Primage was formerly a gratuity paid to the captain of the vessel for taking care of the cargo...

"In addition to this, as primage charges are included in the shipping statement, the merchant has naturally to pay the duty of 20% on the primage charges...

"Double Importation."

"A shipper here sending goods to South Africa is not charged primage because this charge was prohibited by the action of the Government of South Africa."

"I have already stated that this charge is nothing but a black-mail on the part of the powerful steamship owners and agents, &c., as consequence to be tolerated."

"There is a firm in Nairobi which retains a receipt bill at primage charges are included in the draft. It is my belief that this is perfectly correct and justifiable as this method is entirely in the hands of the shipping houses in England over which the buyers have no control whatever."

"Mr. Vincent in seconding the motion said that he entirely agreed with the remarks of Mr. Hamilton with regard to the primage charge and would give it his strongest support. He was convinced that the 20% per cent mentioned by the promoters was recoverable and he understood that some firms did recover it."

"Fright Charge Danger."

"Mr. James said in a lecture of the motion but thought that if the shipping companies were made to finance the primage they would simply add it on to the freight, and did not see any way out of the difficulty."

"Mr. Moynagh in the subsequent discussion, while agreeing with Mr. Hamilton's remarks, said that it appeared to them to be useless to attempt to get primage abolished. He stated that it was no use making suggestions to the Government which were sure that a certain measure of success would attend their efforts. Mr. Vincent then stated that he differed with Mr. Moynagh entirely and gave his hearty support to the mover of the motion, saying that the charge was injurious to every possible endeavour should be made to have these charges abolished."

"Mr. Hamilton in replying to the mover of the motion, said that in particular he entirely disagreed with the remarks taken by Mr. Moynagh and partly remarked that there could be no returns at all every year on the lines suggested by Mr. Moynagh."

"It is also remarked that if agitation did not take place the matter would be accomplished. The motion was then put to the meeting and carried unanimously."
