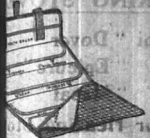

ELECTRICITY BILL
Legislative Council
Discussion
FINAL STAGES

The Legislative Council on Friday held their very short discussion of the supplementary estimate of £28,810 for the services of the year 1915-16 was approved. Also expenditure for the year 1915-16, amounting to £10,900, £4, 5d.

Mr. J. McEllan was then sworn in as a special member, and the Council proceeded to discuss the amendments to the Electric Light and Power Ordinance.

The Electricity Bill was an old matter that was being brought forward and one that had been considerably discussed before. It was essential to get the Bill through as early as possible as everyone appreciated the delay in the matter of electric light and power and that quickly.

Mr. McEllan introduced an amendment from which he was understood to estimate would remove any possible doubt of a licensee of any description from generating or operating electrical energy except under the terms of the Bill and that if a present licensee holder failed to apply for a new licence he would be liable to have his plant and machinery confiscated and to remove any generation from any premises.

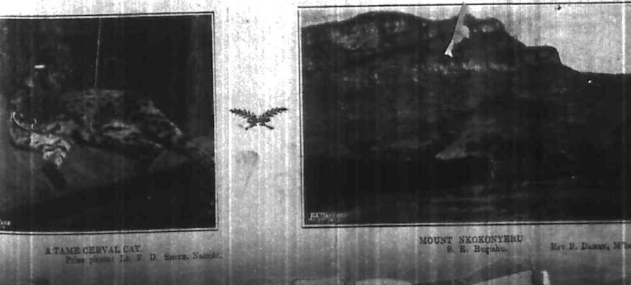

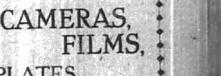
