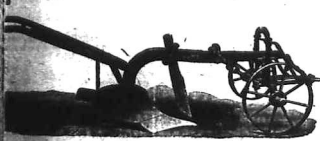

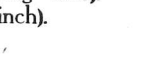
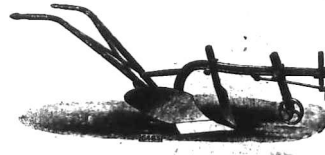

JUDGING

19. The judging will begin at 9:30 a.m. on the first day, and any exhibit not being in position or ready when called upon by the Showman of the Class or Section, will be disqualified.

OWNERSHIP

20. All Exhibits must have been the property of the Exhibitor, and in his or his Agent's possession for at least two months prior to the date of Show; and all Agricultural, Horticultural, or Dairy Produce must be the bona fide product of the Exhibitor.

AWARDING OF PRIZES

21. The Judges are empowered to withhold prizes in any class or classes where they do not consider the Exhibits of sufficient merit, and when there is only one Exhibit in any class, the Judges may award the first, second, or third prize according to the merit of the animal or other Exhibit shown.

AWARDING OF PRIZES

22. All Exhibits will be eligible to compete for Special Prizes and Championship in any Class.

AWARDING OF PRIZES

23. In the event of the Judges awarding more prizes in any class or classes than are provided for in the Schedule, the Committee are empowered to reassign the Prizes in such class or classes so that they do not exceed the total amount of prize money offered for competition, and that successful Exhibitors shall be bound to accept the amounts awarded to them by the Committee in respect of prizes won by them in such class or classes.

POWER TO WITHHOLD PRIZES

24. 27. The Committee will not be responsible for any accident that may be caused elsewhere by any Exhibit, and it shall be a condition of entry that each Exhibitor shall hold the Committee harmless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from such accident.

28. All dogs will be under covered shading, tethered and separated by partitions from each other, and no dogs (except bull terriers) will be allowed to be kept in kennels or kennels during the time of Exhibitions.

29. All dogs must be forward with a suitable leather collar and chain, and must be tethered not later than 8:30 a.m. on the first day of the Show.

NOTICE OF PROTEST

32. The Judge's decision in the matter of merit shall be final; but in case an objection on the ground of fraud or misrepresentation, wilful or otherwise, shall be made to any person receiving or being entitled to a prize or prizes awarded to him by the Judge, the objector shall deposit the sum of Rs. 15 with his protest; and if such objection shall prove false, the deposit shall be forfeited to the Society.

NOTE OF PROTEST

33. Notice of protest or objection, in terms of the foregoing rule, as to the right party to a prize must be given in writing to the Secretary not later than 5 p.m. on the day of judging, stating the reason of such protest; and the decision of the Committee on the hearing of any protest or objections shall be absolutely binding upon all parties.

JUDGES' INTRODUCTIONS

34. 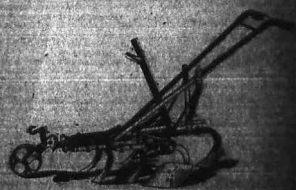
