BR. ZILLIAN COFFEE.

Two Days' Frost Does Great Damage.

The following is an extract from the "Times" (London). The reports which have reached this country by cable of the injury which the Coffee crop of the State of Sao Paulo has suffered from two days frost have hardly conveyed a full indication of the damage done. The private reports appear to be so exaggerated, that the Sao Paulo Government appointed a Commission to investigate them. The report, issued by mail, shows that the damage was very serious. In the State of Sao Paulo, according to the Commission, 80 per cent. of the Coffee trees were destroyed, or the equivalent, that it will be years before they can yield as before. Not only coffee, but sugarcane and plantations were materially damaged. According to generally accepted estimates, the number of bearing coffee trees in Brazil was 270,000,000. Of these, some 361,000,000 are said to have been killed, while the new plantations not yet bearing are reported to be destroyed. It is calculated that only from 10,000,000 to 12,000,000, and as before the frost, even on the coffee trees that all the destroyed trees be replaced. The expected effect upon the railways of the state is shown in a generally accepted estimate, giving for 1918 12,000,000 bags, for 1919 14,000,000 bags, and for 1920 6,000,000 bags.

In commenting upon the damage to the coffee crop, the October report of the London and Brazilian Bank states that, although the damage done can only be judged upon as a very serious calamity instead of the individual fazendeiros, it may be to some extent regarded as a blessing in disguise to the State in a whole, as a result of the coffee crisis, and also make the fazendeiros pay more attention to the cultivation of other products, but probably chiefly cotton, the growth of which has almost everywhere increased during the past few years.

Of course, this year's coffee crop 1918-19 is in no way affected, except that it would fetch a much better price. As will be seen from our usual Brazilian market report, considerable amounts, particularly in the coffee market, has developed coffee plantations. All the remaining coffee plantations have advanced further to 12 1/2 lb.

INDIGENOUS WELFARE.

The foundation may be spiritual, but still possible.
 Labor: The mother of every virtue and every body must work six days per week and the seventh to rest, etc., such a foundation can we accomplish? It may be difficult, but still possible.
 Government: civil, mission, planters, now settlers, advise the natives to work, wherever they like, to their own benefit, not to others.
 To something to occupy their minds and bodies and engage themselves night hours for day as the Romans do. As all over the world every one is doing.
 Religion: The Government was making this as a law, so shall see the success before long.
