Lord Weir, the Air Minister, has issued a future for flying of great importance to the B.E.A., which stands to be benefited by its economic use. Now that the accumulations of produce formerly awaiting shipment have been cleared, the Homeward Loading Sub-Committee has decided to discontinue the system of pro rata allotment which has in some instances acted unsafely owing to new stocks being made to rank equally for allotment with produce which had accumulated over a long period, and to allow in future an strict registration rotation which will have the effect of securing that consignments will be shipped more or less in the order of production and will eliminate the necessity for "part consignments" shipments.

2. Producers of Exporters are notified that if from any cause they are unable to fill any of the consignments allotted it will be necessary to re-register such consignments which will then only be available for allotment after previous registrations have been shipped.  
3. Owing to the uncertain movements of steamers it will often be necessary to call for produce at short notice, and Producers and Exporters are warned to register only such consignments as are actually available for shipment.

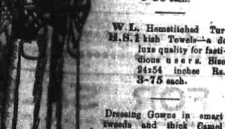

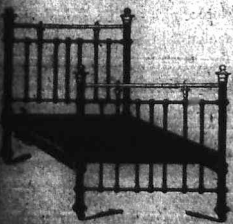

AS OTHERS SEE US Call for grants to our Soldier Settlers BEDFORD APPEAL In the "Bedfordshire Times," to be had by the last mail, containing a notice which will be read in B.E.A. with interest. It runs:- Sir:- The attention of the public has been called from time to time to the possibilities of British East Africa as a field for the settlement of thousands of our people who wish to better their positions and to find openings for growing families. The letters of Lord Joffre to "The Times" have so far done much to convince those who have read them of the prospects of the country, but the fact remains that without the sanction of Government to overcome the difficulties of the climate and of transport the exploitation of this settlement can neither be rapid nor successful. But, surely, Sir, the lessons of the war have been hardly learnt unless we are prepared for a vigorous and extensive colonial expansion. The soil of East Africa can yield to British hands and arms the raw materials of our manufactures and the essentials of life for a large part of our population. The opportunity is now when that of the right kind from Navy and Army will soon be to be released. Many of the necessities are at hand in the shape of boats, transport wagons, motor and electrical appliances, food and clothing. The only further requirement is the grant of a sum of money. The sum recommended by a few days' war expenditure would open out vast prospects in the near future, and would help to solve some of the problems with which we shall soon be faced. I mean those problems of labour and unemployment. Why not make Africa a British Continent for all time? Why not swamp the German colonies with what was German East Africa? What little effect it might have upon our finances? What golden streams of the future would be opened up by the new spending of a few millions in port roads and railways. It has been said that the capture of Constantinople will start a new era in our British past of imagination and failure to bring new ideas to the world. This may be true. But could you not see Sir, through the columns of your journal bring to the present continent a new and useful contribution in the advocacy of a great new development of the Empire lands. Upon all that is done in Britain will rest the shadow of the old land and the old times. But in the new lands beyond the sea an extension of the Empire may be realised in a few years which would settle for ever many of the old rivalries between the nations. It is estimated that East Africa alone would support a population of some millions. Under the aegis of the British Empire a new United States of Africa would do as much as a League of Nations to confirm the future of the world.
