B. E. A.'s WAR MEMORIAL  
Suggestion for Imposing Figure  
Group of Statuary

DR. ARTHUR OUTLINES HIS SCHEME

To the B.E.A. Standard.  
Sir,—I have followed the many suggestions appearing in your paper from time to time, regarding the proposed National War Memorial for B.E.A., with expectancy, but regret to say up to now with disappointment. It is disappointing that the sentiment on which one would think the idea should be based, has been almost entirely absent.

What is it that is wanted? Is it not something commemorative, distinctive, grand, big, conspicuous, something to catch the eye, to stir the heart, to command the reverence of those that pass by? There are occasions, and this is emphatically one, when sentiment should yield and the question of material needs stand by.

What is there to impose the feelings in a building, however grand, who would notice it when the novelty had gone, and it came to slip to be any everyday public building? Again, what would it signify to our large native population so nearly concerned with the World War?

Suggesting Nelson's memorial was a library, or such, instead of the grand imposing monument that it is, would it have had the effect of stirring the deep patriotic feelings that it has done on hundreds of occasions? The more sight, the picture reveals, to overcome Britons, stir the emotions to an untold degree in a time of crises.

Why choose B.E.A. have something emblematic and inspiring, and forget for a little moment the future material wants? Might I venture to suggest the following:

A statue of an E.A.M.B. trooper, mounted, in typical uniform, shorts, shirtwaist, etc., and at the base, in various strategic figures of the war, should be suitably inscribed, and with the names of those who fell deeply engraved. This to be placed at the head of Sixth Avenue on the line of entry into Government Road, mid-way between Mackenzie's and Nairobi House.

The suggested site may perhaps appear, as it would create a diversion of traffic, that is badly needed at this point.

THE ADOPTED IDEA

At the public meeting in connection with the proposed war memorial held in Nairobi on Wednesday, Dr. Arthur of Kilindi, who formed the nucleus of the motion eventually adopted. In the course of his remarks, Dr. Arthur said there appeared to be two conflicting ideas with regard to the memorial for Nairobi, one with a logic for all, and one the country districts to have their own memorials. The weakness in such a scheme was that many districts were unable to supply their own memorials, and also that the majority of the population, being of Indian and native descent.

The second idea was for a strong central memorial representing the whole Protectorate as a unity, and the capital, the colony, and the districts who had died. In this latter scheme all sections would be embraced.

a large public hall with offices, an information bureau, etc., where district associations could meet, with a central library, and also a museum and library, (b) a war memorial institute to embrace and combine a war memorial hall or loggia with tablets and statuary, and where also could be put the war trophies collected from G.E.A.

B.E.A. CURIOS

There also could be a technical institute and museum, which would be educational and informative in an objective, and would embrace in its collections:

- (1) The present museum collection.
- (2) Other collections in agricultural, geological, forest, medical, and other departments which would become far more general, useful than they are at present hidden away in inconvenient places.
- (3) Information bureau, which would be available for all in the colony, and where the things were likely to come in the future.
- (4) Library and reading room, where the best reference books would be collected together from all present sources—and there were many in the Protectorate—and made available for all. Thus a doctor could manage to find a library of reference that he himself could not possibly obtain individually; so with other people of their own particular branch of science. Further, he saw no reason why the best fiction and poetry, carefully selected, might not also be available.
- (5) A lecture room where lectures could be given periodically by specialists in the various branches, and where teachers could bring their classes for illustrative lectures on special topics. The educational value for all classes of the community could not be overestimated, for the white and coloured children at any age, and for natives he hoped in a very special way.
- (6) Public gardens, laid down to make the surroundings attractive and useful.

REVENUE

With regard to sources of revenue, Dr. Arthur referred to the large plot available for an historical museum which had an excellent and central site, unimpeded by being enclosed by other buildings. All funds from all over the country could be centralized and the Government would, he considered, be willing to give a very considerable grant. Also the Natural History Society fund of £500 and balances from all the various funds collected during the war might also be available.

As regards upkeep, it would necessarily have to be taken over by Government and therefore its future would be assured, and not left to chance subscriptions, etc., to keep it up.

A curator and librarian would, of course, be necessary. Also officers working the scientific sections of the Government would concentrate their efforts in the building, and would be available for guidance and help in connection with their special branches of work.

Soldiers Before Civil Servants  
TELLING PROTEST  
MOMBASA INQUIRY

The Bitter, B.A. Standard

Sir,—With reference to the following extract from the Nairobi letter published in your edition of today's date: "By the way, I have any truth in the remark that the British soldiers are to be sent to the tropics, home and to Egypt." If this is the case it will be hard luck for the civil servants, but I am sure that they are glad that there are so many people living at the present day who could write such an absolute sentence. If the writer thinks that local people should have precedence over a British officer, who has given an exceptional service to the country, his moral outlook must be very poor.

If you will kindly allow me space I would like to quote my case. I am married and have one child. Although in the promotion to join up, I was always ready to go, I was "indispensable" in February 1915. I was advised to remain a civilian as that I resigned, and after being compelled to go out a month's notice, eventually succeeded in getting into the army after three times being certified medically unfit. I received the maximum pay of one shilling and sixpence per day, out of which I had to repay sixpence a month so that my wife could draw her little income, and I was unable to keep my child. Consequently our total loss was £20 a week.

After being refused permission to proceed on active service (medically unfit) on many occasions I was eventually allowed to return with a discharge in April 1917. Each day that I am unemployed I remark in this country makes it harder for the British soldier to get an appointment at home. The High Command has been seen up to enable my wife and child to live, and we have been for some time entirely dependent on my wife's pay, which as most people know, is not sufficient. My wife and I have been in the hospital for some time and have all been on active service, and we have all been in Egypt. My case is only one of thousands of similar cases, and I have no doubt that there are many more.

In view of the foregoing can the writer of the Nairobi letter really be voicing the opinion of local people, I can hardly say, but I think that they are very mostly of the opinion that the Imperial soldier has every right to precedence over the V.A. etc., etc.

"ONLY A TOMMY"

Nairobi, May 7  
I, who have been in the Protectorate, who has given their lives in thousands for the Empire, should have a special consideration in the matter. 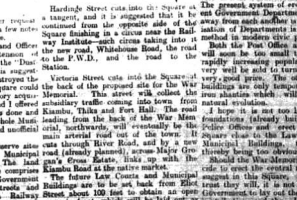
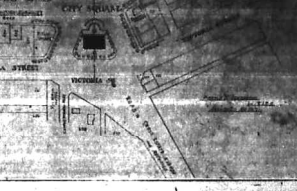

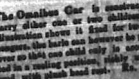
