There were left on the beach of the steamer for days, and they were informed that they could only be landed on a water's side. But they were landed and actually had freight to the extent of Rs. 100-00 and had no provisions.

That week of rain was most unpropitious, and to say the least about it, it was not broken.

THE NEW WAYFARER.

Mr. Foulkes in the course of his journey on the new wayfarer for the lake was intended to cover the route on the boats by the company's own servants. The wayfarer was intended to follow the lake and the Indian railways. The Indian railways had very strict regulations, but one could go at ordinary times into the parks, about it, and discuss their grievances or losses, and they were always willing to discuss their claims.

Here it was the very opposite, the railway was most unpropitious, and there was no way left to receive what was owed, they could get no satisfaction. They could not sue for business on these lines; they had to go to court, extra charges for the maintenance of railway servants, it seemed to him the servants of the railway were not paid a sufficient salary to enable them to live honestly.

He then gave this instance in which the railway dealt with a consignment of 30 bags of flour. His people had advanced money on it. When the goods arrived, 10 bags could be found to have been taken to go? They could get no redress. Sometimes they in Uganda were not allowed to take a legal case, so they thought of taking one of the many cases to the Friesly Court. But a change in the law made it impossible to do this, they decided to wait. These railway ways could not get over the ordinary law of the country, the company could not get out of their responsibility for the negligence of their servants.

With reference to the new rule and new goods for money, Mr. Foulkes said he had not wanted to send them, but they had been quite sufficient to cover the ordinary risk of travel, they had to pay a certain rate, and they did not want to pay a very high rate for their goods, but they had no protection for their goods, and these things were essential, and adding to their costs in this country, and they had to compete with other countries.

Referring to the lake transport to say they had a distance of 800 miles to carry. The ordinary railway was less than 100 miles, and the cost of carrying the goods from the lake to the coast was more than 100 miles, the more goods the railway carried the greater their income would be, the charges for their costs should become. They did not want to be eternally up against the railway; they ought to work in hand.

Mr. Cameron said the new wayfarer put a distinct premium on pilfering; and it had a tendency to call them into open seas, pilfering had developed during the last six months more than ever. The railway was not always the same, it did not matter what the complaint was. With regard to the service generally, they got no redress, but they had to give the note.

Another point was the connection and arrangements of the service at Namagali. The steamer arrived at 8 a.m. on Monday, and the train left at 1.30 on Monday. The passengers were then tied up at Namagali, the most convenient available position for 11 days. Why?

THE RISK NOTE.

After Mr. Fraser and Mr. Merry weather had given instances of absurd handling of money and of pilfering, Mr. Smith raised the question of risk notes. "A." Before they could ship a cargo they had to sign the risk note. "A." that note informed them they were shipping their stuff in bad condition. The note was in perfect condition otherwise they were voided. His first experience was to receive a note and having signed it, he found that was what the risk note meant, the railway company accept the goods. "A." said he was putting a premium on dishonesty.

Mr. Woodward gave one or two instances of where his goods were delivered in a damaged condition, and also where they had been manifestly stolen.

Mr. Buckley suggested that with regard to the railway risk an extra 10 per cent. would cover the railway risk and enable the companies to do a profitable business with them.

Mr. House asked when they might get the advantage on pilfering of the railway. Foulkes gave one instance of the loss of a basket, the goods were in the basket, the loss was under the company, he could do nothing.
