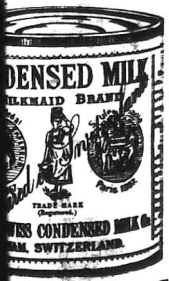

### NAIROBI RING ROAD.

A member of the Town Planning and Public Health Committee of the Nairobi Municipal Council held on December 19, when the present Councilors Tannahill (in the chair), the Hon. Mr. Maxmwell also the M.O.H. and Mr. Maxwell of the P.W.D. the following is the Committee's report:

TURF CLUB BALL

No date has been left untripped by the E. A. Turf Club, to make the forthcoming Nairobi Race Meeting, January 21st and 22nd a large and representative of the "E. A. Standard" was held by Mr. A. Vincent, the Turf Club's secretary, which gave the starting order for the races on December 21st, and also the names of the horses coming in a most satisfactory manner. These forthcoming races will be a considerable event in the blood on the course, in the shape of a number of South African thoroughbreds which have just been arriving from the Cape. The first meeting will be a two days affair, with eight good races on each day, the first race to start at 12.30 on Saturday, and the same as usual, but once again reminded of the following classes:

All horse owners are reminded that all horse owners of country bred mares must register to the Secretary before 21st November 21, and the same for all stallions must be registered within six months of date of birth.

In the event of two or more horses belonging to the same owner, running in a race in the same colors, distinguishing caps must be worn.

There will also be a Turf Club ball on January 9 at the New Stanley Hotel. On the January 30 and 31 we will see the first race meeting at Nairobi, under the auspices of the E. A. Turf Club. This will be a two days meeting instead of a one day affair, and the Turf Club hopes that this innovation will tend to be such a success as to necessitate all future meetings at Nairobi also being two day meetings on January 30 and 31.

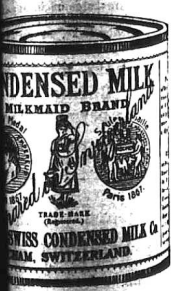

LONDON BUCKINGHAM.

(From Our London Correspondent.)

London, Dec. 20. As a result of the War it was always expected that there would be an increase in the criminal classes. Great Britain and possessions have been visited. For the last eight months the authorities record an exceptional number of cases of violence; the average annual total number of murders more than doubled last year, and common law offences were also increased. Then the Law stopped in successful in most cases in tracing and punishing the criminals, and the Government re-established a wholesale support for constabulary. As a result this type of crime has been again to diminish.

Now, however, there is a new type of crime which quite ordinary and only resorts to violence as a secondary consideration. These are a large and small number of cases of terrorism. They are not the result of chance action, or distress driving people to desperate crimes, but are the operation of a gang of men who work with varying degrees of cleverness and with very varying degrees of success.

Thus within the last few months there have been three great cases of robbery on the East coast, one on the route from the Cape. In all cases the diamonds were stolen from the men, who in some cases were also participants with a very close knowledge of the working of the Post Office.

Criminal records in this country have nearly always shown that when the mail has been robbed contacts connected with the Post Office or the Railway Company has been involved. Apparently these are suspects, but some of the three affairs seem likely to be cleared up.

Hotel Theaters are the hotel robberies. Thefts of valuables and jewels in the leading hotels are almost an everyday occurrence, and the fact has been traced in connection with any of them. They are not all thefts committed in bedrooms, but often take place in hotel lounges and cloak rooms, which shows that the thieves must be circulating as guests.

In the same category are the modern bandit of this type is as well dressed as, and probably better dressed than most of those who frequent any public places of entertainment, and they are obviously of both sexes because some of the robberies take place in apartments devoted to ladies only.

Another class of man is carrying out the motor car robberies of which there are daily complaints. In these cases the Police have managed to capture a fairly large number of people, who apparently sometimes work in gangs of ten or twelve and the evidence has shown that there are quite a few receivers as well. who are not more hoodlums, but who are more sophisticated and who are known as business rogues.
