BRUSSELS CONFERENCE

Important Reports on International Finance

GOLD VALUES

London, October 8. Reuter learns from Brussels that the reports of four committees of the International Financial Conference dealing with International Trade, International Credits, Currency and Exchange and Public Finance, have been presented to the Conference which has adopted them unanimously.

The reports overlap considerably but the most important is that on Currency and Exchange which declines to recommend the stabilization of the value of gold. It states doubts as to whether any such attempt would succeed and considers that neither International Currency nor an International Unit of Account would serve any useful purpose.

It also regards artificial control of exchange operations as futile.

The other reports strongly emphasize the necessity of all Governments restricting expenditure to the limits of revenue and to improve taxation to meet deficits. A plan is also described for enabling States to facilitate a obtaining of commercial credits by their nationals.

MESOPOTAMIA

All's Well in the Kufa Garrison

London, Oct. 7. A War Office communique states: "Our relief column moving on Samawah has reached Durrah station, 20 miles from the town. Reconnoitering aeroplanes have observed all's well signals from the Kufa garrison, but Arabs are destroying the Kufa-Rasul line."

The march of a column marching to Hillah from Baghdad was attacked at Al-Mudhaya, which is 19 miles south of Baghdad, by insurgents when an armoured train dispersed."

IRISH PEACE

Lord Grey and Sir Asquith's Outlook

London, Oct. 8. Viscount Grey, in a further communication to the Westminster Gazette, replies to Mr. Asquith's criticism. He suggests in regard to naval power that Mr. Asquith proposes to give Ireland only the same power as those accorded to the Dominions and this will be qualified in practice owing to the geographical position of Ireland.

Lord Grey further states that Ireland can no longer be regarded as "a trust" adding that it is a failure, and that he considers the treaty was to fulfil our trust to Ireland to wind up British management of the island which is partly Irish affairs.

AMERICAN GROWTH

Big Increase in Population

London, Sept. 6. Reuter learns from New York that the official census of the population of the United States shows that 105,000,000 in 1910 and 120,000,000 in 1920, an increase of 15 per cent. compared with the 1910 census.

COAL CRISIS

Hope and Disappointment Still Alternating

SMILLIE'S ADVICE

London, Oct. 7. The coal situation has grown worse owing to the Council of the Yorkshire Miners' Association overwhelmingly recommending its members to vote against any datum line. This is a surprising development, as it had been confidently anticipated that Yorkshire would strongly support peace.

Mr. Robert Smillie in a statement at Glasgow advised the miners to vote for the acceptance of the owners' offer as a temporary measure and to settle down for three months, during which time an agreement satisfying to the miners might be reached.

Mr. Smillie's appeal is significant in view of the fact that hitherto important coal miners' organizations have recommended the rejection of the owners' offer.

SOVIET AND BRITAIN

Qualified Acceptance of New Terms

London, Oct. 7. Reuter learns that the Soviet Government's reply to Earl Curzon's note of October 6 is (not?) wholly satisfactory. It gives no undertaking to abstain from propaganda, but agrees to repatriate all British prisoners in Russia in exchange for Russian prisoners in the hands of British troops and also to release British prisoners in Baku outside its jurisdiction.

The Soviet declared its willingness to send a representative to Tiflis to urge the Azerbaijan Government to release them, and proposes that Britain should also send a representative thither.

The reply is not regarded as final and it is understood a further British note will be dispatched.

LEAGUE TO MEET

Great Preparations for Geneva Conference

55 STATES

London, Oct. 7. Great preparations are being made for the first session of the Assembly of the League of Nations which is meeting at Geneva in November.

Work is in progress on the Palais des Nations, the newly acquired headquarters of the League on the shores of the lake. The Missions of the 41 States, now forming the League, together with their staffs will number 1,000 persons, while 12 fresh small States are seeking admission to the League.

PORTUGUESE STRIKE

Contradictory Reports of Alleged Revolution

London, Oct. 7. Reuter learns from Madrid that travellers from Portugal confirm that a general strike has broken out throughout the country.

Government officers declare that it is a revolutionary movement.

Postal, telegraph and telephone employees, Naval reserves, railwaymen and dockers have all ceased work, while reports from Vigo state that Lisbon, Oporto and all the other big towns in Portugal are in revolt.

The Portuguese Legation in London states that the reports of strikes in Portugal are exaggerated.

A telegram from Portugal dated yesterday has been received by the Legation and it merely refers to partial railway strike on the Companhia Portuguesa. The telegram also states that the bulk of the employees are remaining at their posts; many trains are running and order is undisturbed.

HOULI'S LOAN

London, October 8. The "Times" states that a prospectus is being issued of a new British loan amounting for £15,000,000, of 8 per cent. local loan stock issued at 50 for nominal and other terms.

HOME TRADE

Another Advance Towards Good Balance

London, October 8. The Board of Trade returns for September record another monthly increase of exports and the lowest total imports since last November.

Exports total £177,500,000, an increase of £1,000,000 compared with September, 1919; imports, £152,500,000, an increase of £4,000,000.

The export of cotton yarns and manufactures registered an advance of nearly £20,000,000, and those of woollen and worsted yarns and manufactures, £3,000,000.

RED PRICES

London, Oct. 7. A Sevastopol news item dated October 2 confirms the reports that the Bolsheviks are completely demoralized. They are evacuating Ekaterininsk and Povorot and are withdrawing their supply trains for long distances. The retreat is impeded by peasant risings.

The correspondent quotes a few ruling prices showing that a bit out costs 1,000 roubles, butter 8,000 roubles, per pound, lump sugar 12,000 roubles, newspapers 500 roubles each and eggs 250 each.

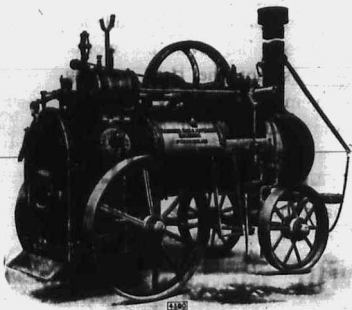

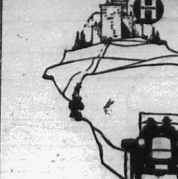

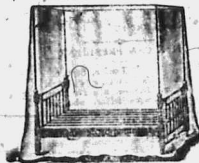
