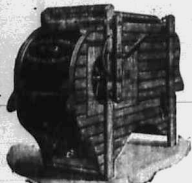

THE B.O.R.

The mass of information evolved
 from the painful experience of gener-
 ations of chess players and recorded
 by some of them for our benefit
 is known as the "book." In
 particular, the words are used to
 denote the plan of the opening,
 and a "book" player is the title
 rather scornfully given to one who
 memorizes expert variations by
 heart, but has little real know-
 ledge of the game. When such a
 "player" comes to the end of his
 "book" variation, or should he ap-
 parently unwillingly refuse to make
 the stipulated move, it is spent in
 the tragedy in the nursery which
 is recalled:
 "If the book had lasted longer
 his game would have been
 stronger."

Then we find at the other extreme
 those who, possibly least, sometimes
 intelligently, but they never opened
 a chess-book in their lives, and
 they will be hurt if it is that
 they can do a little of play.
 For such people go on making the
 same mistakes in the opening for
 scores, when a little casual reading
 of the book would very soon show
 them their errors. It is certain
 that a player with a real book
 knowledge will beat one without it,
 after the time being equal.
 The enthusiastic beginner gener-
 ally overstates the recorded vari-
 ations of the opening until he has
 digested them his playing
 strength will fall off a little under
 this strain. The best method for
 most novices is to learn the chief
 lines of play in a few standard open-
 ings, such as the Ray Lopez and
 Queen's Gambit. The two most im-

 French, Sicilian, and
 should also have a general idea of
 the way to proceed. While

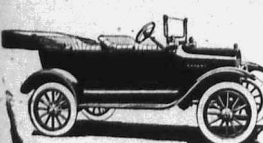

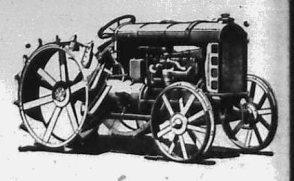

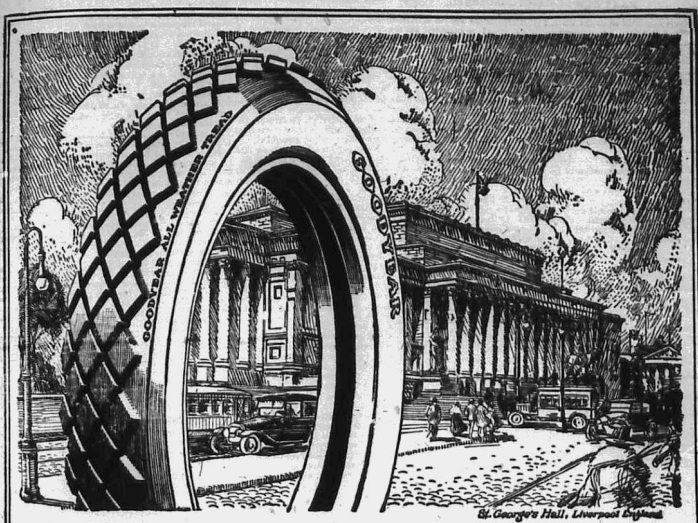
