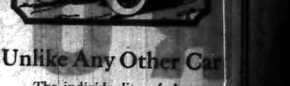



**PAINTING OF NOTES IMPRACTICABLE**

The report of the sub-committee is based on a study of the various proposals which have been made for the purpose of making the notes more difficult to counterfeit. It is pointed out that the only practical method of making the notes more difficult to counterfeit is by the use of a watermark.

**ACTIVATION OF NOTES**

Turning their attention to the other method suggested, namely, the use of a watermark, the sub-committee found that a sufficient number of the notes which were to be called in would be made up of notes which were already in circulation.

**TWO PRACTICABLE ALTERNATIVES**

It appears to the Committee that two practical alternatives, only present themselves. The first is to wait until new shilling notes are issued, and then to call in the old notes.


