### THE NEW EPIDEMIC.

The Mystery Disease of Sleeping Sickness  
**NOT UNLIKE 'BEE-BEE'**

FROM OUR OWN CORRESPONDENT.  
London, Feb. 27.

The London Ministry of Health advises that the new mystery disease—the first since the Spanish influenza epidemic—known as sleeping sickness is spreading throughout the country. It is not altogether unlike 'bee-bee', the true sleeping sickness of tropical Africa, but cases of being made to discover the germ, which causes the disease, though up to the present there has been no success.

It is believed that the germ enters the blood through the nose and gets into the brain, causing a form of paralysis. Symptoms are being made by medical doctors and the results, when published, will undoubtedly prove of importance to Africa.

**GUANJA COTTON.**

This subject was mentioned at the monthly meeting of the Council of the British Cotton-growing Association at Manchester that week, when it was stated that this year's crop from Uganda was estimated at 75,000 bales, the highest total in any previous year being 45,000 bales in 1920. The meeting was given to understand that, notwithstanding the slump in cotton prices, no application is felt as to the whole of this crop being marketed at a price which should not discourage native growers.

It may be worth mentioning that the Government has decided, at the meeting, to make a contribution of £200 to the London School of Tropical Medicine.



**FLAX MARKET**  
 Latest Report of the World's Production

**MUCH STEADIER**

The following report on the world's flax market has been prepared by Messrs. Wigglesworth & Co., Ltd., dated Feb. 2.

**MARKET CONDITIONS.**

The steady, somewhat report on our last article of Feb. 2 has been developed. During January the demand for Dutch and Belgian flax has removed the accumulation of stocks there, and is expected to be followed by a corresponding value of those flaxes, especially in the lower end, from 200 to 250 per ton.

The buying which has been most active in the past fortnight has been principally on the part of Russia, Sweden, Italy and Germany, especially the latter, while British buyers have also been in the market, though not to any extent, as they are much preoccupied with the bad condition of the linen trade and the difficulty of selling yarn. The demand for Irish flax has also improved and it is expected that considerable quantities have been secured principally by Americans, as prices in favour of the buyers.

The international agreement of a minimum price for yarn which was established last November has been abandoned and prices are now allowed a free market for the first year, when they fell to a reduction of fully 50 per cent.

The price of yarn is now coming into sympathy with the reduced price for flax and this will stimulate not only the demand for yarn but for linen. It will undoubtedly be a relief to the trade in England, as it is only fair that the same amount should get the benefit of the lower prices now ruling for raw material.

There have been complaints from many quarters especially from the United States, of the high prices asked for flax and the attempts made to maintain a higher price was justified by the cost of raw material, and there has been a rise in the price of the manufacture of products it is possible that business would not have reached such a stagnant condition as it has been for the last six months.

The linen trade still continues in an extremely unsatisfactory state and in Scotland a very large amount of machinery is out of operation, especially in the north, where many of the mills using the class of material have been shut down for about six months. In the north of Ireland the mills and factories which decided to shut down for a month's Christmas holidays will have had to continue shut down for a further month. This will have the effect of eventually improving the situation, but at the moment it is certainly the cause of great hardship.

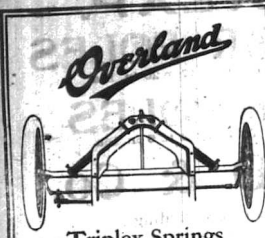

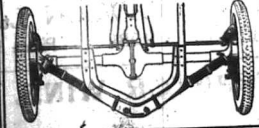
