A MORTGAGE ON AN UNCERTAIN FUTURE

The letting of the contract for Kilindi Plain by the Secretary of State to Messrs. Phipps threatens to involve this Colony in the most wasteful and unproductive expenditure...

We referred yesterday to the fact that it was undertaken before the Secretary of State had received and considered the recommendations of Sir C. F. D. Hammond, the Special Commissioner of Railways, Eastern Africa, or the general public.

We are now able to assert that those recommendations comprise fundamental modifications of the contract.

It is not clear, moreover, that they will not materially affect the cost of the scheme. The fact that the Special Commissioner suggested that the ground for the proposed station should be better before the contract is put out to tender gives further weight to the supposition that the financial aspect is important.

In addition there are railway works, which not only will involve additional expenditure but may also materially modify the plans under the contract as issued.

It is to be assumed that the points on which General Hammond offers constructive criticism in his original report on the contract now granted, and that the country is thus saddled not only with a scheme which is in principle extravagant and wasteful, but also with a contract which is in all respects defective.

The taxpayer of the Colony has to pay for expensive works which are not adopted immediately on completion or perquisite duty which is insufficient.

We shall endeavour next week to prove the impracticability of the scheme becoming self-supporting for many years, and the unwisdom of reliance on the fact interest and sinking fund does not begin to fall until the fourth year. It is assumed that by that time the war will be settling, and the country bankrupt.

The high prices of three years ago, or even of 12 months ago and their disastrous collapse are too fresh in the minds of most of us not to give a shattering effect on future anticipations. The relation of the railway to its actual hypochondria, mortgages an uncertain future.

If the future is reasonably bright, and three years hence Kenya is progressing and not merely solvent, the interest and sinking fund will be met, but the Government will have a heavy handicap.

If we and the world have not yet surmised the depths of depression and the present man does not dismiss the possibility what then?

It is the Colonist office proposal to accept responsibility in Kenya is compelled to state:

The postponement of these works, and the utilisation of the funds for other more productive schemes, are essential measures of self protection and insurance.
