THE ANNUAL BLUEBOOKS.
B. E. A. and Uganda.
THEIR EXCELLENCE'S REPORTS.

Reports on the East Africa and Uganda Protectorates are issued from the Colonial Office. The former says—
 The results of the year again will be for the more or less successful prosecution of the imports and exports show a satisfactory and steady increase. Practically the net trade for the Protectorate has declined within the last four years, and considering that it only started 12 years ago the figure of £1,077,000 representing the net trade of the Protectorate for the year shows that rapid progress has been made. In the total included the trade of the neighboring Protectorate of Uganda and the German Lake Ports from which hitherto most of the exports were derived.

In the matter of exports, East Africa is still far behind Uganda and the Lake Ports, as is evidenced by the railway and Customs returns. With the attention that is now being paid to stimulating the cultivation of payable products and as our industry advances it is to be hoped that this disparity may soon disappear.

Rubber and Fibre.
 Of the indigenous products, to which we look with the most confidence as important factors in the commercial future of the country, rubber and fibre may be considered the most important. Several concessions for rubber have been given and rubber plantations have started, whilst two of the fibre concessions are working. Saw machinery and machinery has been ordered for fibre plantations, which will be now commencing to be placed on the market from plantations in various parts of the world, and it is discouraging to note the serious fall in prices which has now quoted both for rubber and fibre. It is to be hoped that rubber can be utilized for many other purposes than those to which it is at present put, and that the rubber exhibition which is to be held in London next September will help towards revivifying the minds of this country and raising its price again to former quotations.

Sheep and Cattle.
 The experimental introduction of wool-bearing sheep promises well, the shipment of wool already made being very favourably reported on. Sheep, both native and imported, of three weths in the splendid grazing areas of East Africa and the improvement of the indigenous breeds has been attended with marked success. The cattle industry has lately had a set-back, owing to the outbreak and spread of African coast fever, but a preventive system has been put in operation, and a preventive system introduced for controlling the movement of cattle, and these measures, together with the Government policy for fencing farms, should have the effect of controlling if not eradicating the scourge. The improvement of the breed of indigenous cattle by crossing them with imported bulls has been extremely successful, and we look forward at no distant date to East Africa, becoming a large producer of dairy produce, for which industry a large area in the highlands is eminently adapted, owing to the fact that for the greater part of the year there is a sufficient amount of green succulent herbage to maintain a full supply of milk.

The industry is one to which much importance is attached: a factory is about to be started, and it is hoped that before long it will not only supply the local market, but export largely to outside markets. The Government is paying particular attention to this project, as it is one which will greatly help the smaller farmer.

Another industry which is likely to become an important asset to the country is the domestication and breeding of ostriches. There are a large number of wild birds of this kind, and the Government, proposing a feather which compares very favourably with the ostrich feather grown in South Africa, and the Government has given permission to register, and settlers to collect eggs and rear for sale young birds. Advantage has been taken of the concession by a good many farmers, and we have now in the pen a very fine young bird.

A good many horses and mules have been imported into the country, and some of the settlers in those parts of the Uganda which are considered to be practically free from horse sickness are taking steps to form small breeding studs of horses.

Agriculture.
 Turning to the agricultural products, there should be a large opening in the supply of various kinds to the Continent. Wheat is a product of which we have no export markets, and possibly some small quantities. We have now been able to introduce into the country two main varieties of this cereal, which are well adapted to this soil and climatic conditions of the Uganda. As regards other farm products, the area under maize has been greatly extended. The increase in this landfall is largely on the increase by the natives, and the cultivation has been taken up both by settlers and by

native. There is no doubt that if more money were spent on the importation of selected farm tools the natives would be greatly enhanced in value.

The collection of leaseweed and of various gums from trees indigenous in the forest is receiving attention.

The cultivation of sun-dried ground, and other oil-producing seeds is being extended. The demand for these commodities is constant as a remunerative price the natives are being taught everywhere the advantage of growing such products as these, and the progress, satisfactorily, the efforts of the Government to develop these commodities for their raw material can be looked upon as one of very great importance.

Customs.
 Of late years the disadvantages attached to the dependence of the Lanceshire gins on the United States for their raw material have become increasingly apparent, and the development of the cultivation of cotton on our accepted Colonial policy. In the East African Protectorate there are large areas of country, particularly on the coast, in the lake side, admirably adapted for the production of this industry, which is being rapidly taken up by syndicates and settlers, and, in addition, vigorous efforts are being made to induce the natives to undertake this cultivation.

Imports and Shipping Service.
 The imports for European Colonies are increasing, particularly in materials, implements and machinery and timber provisions.

One of the greatest needs of the Protectorate is a direct British service with the United Kingdom on regular intervals by vessels of reasonable speed. It might not at first be remunerative, but if our hopes for development of the Protectorate as a reality, it could eventually be run on a paying basis.

Certain mail enterprises which have been alluded to in previous reports, such as hotels and landlines, if efficiently managed, would probably be successful, more particularly now that facilities offered by the Uganda Railway are becoming more widely known and are bringing an ever-increasing stream of tourists and sportsmen into the country.

Uganda.
 Compared with the returns of the previous year, revenue shows an increase of £76,709 to £206,772 or 20.02 per cent. Hat and poll taxes have increased by £25,000 or 19.04 per cent.; trade shows an increase from £200,000 to £141,513, while expenditure has been practically the same, £191,202, as against £191,142 in the former year.

These figures are so distinct as to show an agreeable progress throughout the Protectorate, excepting perhaps in the Nile Province, where the sphere of native administration is for the time being kept within reasonable limits.

In addition to that provided by steadily-expanding revenue, the best indications of good order and contentment are such as may be seen in the responses by the Uganda native population to the measures for the clearance of inhabitants from the shores of the Lake shore, from the Nile to the Kagura River, the field of sleeping sickness infection, and in the possible collection of fish imposed upon lakes.

The only disturbing circumstance in the Protectorate has been an appearance, at the end of the year of unrest among many of the Nile Province, which administration is of an amicable attitude of defiance. It was rapidly suppressed without recourse to force.

New Sports Club for Nairobi.

Affiliation Suggested.
WANTED A SITE.

A general meeting of members and supporters of the Town F. C. was held to discuss the future constitution of the Club.
T. A. Wood in the chair.
Present—Hunt, Hargreaves, Stephens, Hampton, E. G. Ikin, Montagu, Watson, Hild-Martin, Linton, Hawkins, G. Taylor, H. W. Johnson, Magdon, Dallas, McEllan, Wilson, Heyer, D. E. Cooper, Fullagar.
Mr. Wood called to order the meeting and said that those present had been asked to attend in order to discuss the future of the Town F. C. and of sport in general in the town. He had prepared a scheme particularly for the benefit of those who did not actually participate in sport whereby it had hoped to show them the error of their ways in not supporting sport. When he looked round however he found that he had hoped only to see a few spectators. He said that all Britons, whether personally interested in sport or not as players, should take an interest in such organisations as various kinds, because he firmly believed that the foundations of the British Empire rested upon and were due to the sporting instinct, if not sport itself. He considered Colonies to be a sportsman and it was our duty to assist when we found a body ready to start direct into sport, and to encourage such movements to the best of our ability. The chairman then briefly outlined the career of the Town Football Club which had existed for 18 months without any financial support from any but their own pockets. At the club grew the need for members. As a deposition bearing lists signed by nearly 120 townfolk, went to his Grace and asked that an area in the proposed Public Park might be set aside for the purpose.

Mr. Wood then called on the Hon. Secy of the Town F. C. to read certain letters in connection with this application.
The following was presented to H. E. the Governor by the deposition from the Town Football Club—
Nairobi Town Football Club.
The Nairobi Town Football Club was established in February 1917 to provide a means of recreation for football players who resided in or near the heart of the town.
One of the reasons for its inception was the fact that the Parklands Sports Club had refused to admit to membership some of the football players who applied to them.
The Club commenced with a membership of about twenty which has now been almost doubled.
Having no ground the Town Football Club approached the Railway Authorities and obtained permission to use the Railway Institute field at a small rental.
The "Double Football Cup" was presented to the Club by Mr. Dobbin, one of the founders of the Club.
The Club furnished a team which met the Gyakubaka Club in the final round for the Cup.



News

Mr. H. Fain, proprietor of the Royal Hotel, an Honorary Member of the Club has just imported another handsome cup for competition, among the Football Clubs in B.E.A. The Club will meet to select a team to represent to meet a team of the Hill Valley Sports Club.

The want of a permanent ground presents the Club from enlarging its scope, and taking up Cricket, Hockey or Tennis by means of which it could greatly increase its membership and sphere of usefulness.
It was felt that the Club should establish itself before asking for a ground. Parklands will be required for the residents in its use for away and moreover residential houses will be required for the residents in its use. The Gyakubaka is essentially an "officers' Club" though the Railway Club, which they could leave the Town Football Club Members permission to use their ground.
There should be a central football ground area where an incident of the Town could include in sport of various kinds by becoming a number of the Town Club. The grounds of which would be responsible for the upkeep of the grounds and gear etc. What the Town Football Club would want would become one branch of the General Club and would be open for membership to all.
H. E. the Governor promised to give his support to the Club, and hoping that the matter had been referred to the Land Office, the Honorary Secretary wrote the following letter

Nairobi, 29th June 1920.

THE LAND OFFICER, NAIROBI.

Dear Sir,—In order to clear up any misunderstanding that may exist on the subject of the application of this Club for a playing field in the proposed Public Park I am directed to inform you that the deposition which was granted an interview with H. E. yesterday, their request as follows—
That an area suitable and large enough for the purpose of recreation be reserved in the proposed Public Park for the use of the Nairobi Town Football Club.
That this area be vested in the Municipality in trust for the Town F. C. being the only Club of any kind at present existing in the town should become the nucleus of a General Recreation Club to be appointed by the townpeople, of which it would eventually become a branch.
My Committee therefore trust that the Hon. the Commissioner of Lands will bear these particulars in mind when allocating such an area as is desired—Yours faithfully,

Having read the foregoing correspondence Mr. Pailthorpe stated that His Excellency had promised to give the application his support.

The question of the establishment of a General Club was next discussed and it was proposed by Mr. F. J. Magdon, seconded by Mr. Hampton that a club be formed to be called the Nairobi Town Sports Club. But to the meeting this was carried unanimously.
Mr. T. A. Wood was then elected President of the Club, and Mr. F. J. Magdon Vice-President, Mr. Pailthorpe Hon. Secy and Mr. A. E. Linton Hon. Treas.

It was proposed and carried that the Nairobi Town Sports Club Committee members, with the President, Hon. Secy and Hon. Treas. be office members. Four to form a quorum.
As it is proposed to dissolve the Town F. C. and amalgamate with the Town N. C. it was proposed that the Town F. C. elect five Committee Members and this meeting elect the remaining five. This was carried. Messrs. P. A. Magdon, H. W. Johnson, G. Taylor, J. Mackinnon and E. S. Hargreaves were accordingly elected Committee Members a proposition that the number of Vice-Presidents should be unlimited was then put to the meeting and carried and a number of suggestions having been made it was resolved that those names be handed to the Committee who should have power to add to the number.

It was next proposed that when the Town Football Club came to be dissolved a meeting of the Sports Club Committee be called to arrange by-Laws and Rules and obtain members subsequently to call a General Session & Co.
For the information and guidance of the Committee it was proposed that the subscription for active members be £1. 1s. 6d. and for Honorary Members £1. 12s. 6d. a payable half yearly in advance.

The meeting then closed with a vote of thanks to the chair.
