A REPUBLIC FROM JANUARY.

NATIONALIST DEMAND

(INDIAN AGENTS' AGENTS.) Ahmedabad, Dec. 31. A free India for the establishment of a Republic designated the United States of India with its own mixed Parliament was made by Hazrat Mohani in his Presidential Address at the Annual Session of the All India Muslim League. Mr. Ghaffar was present.

Mr. Mahari, who did not believe in long time proposals that the Republic should be declared on January 1 and should be attained by all possible means, including guerilla warfare, the great of the Proclamation of martial law.

RAPTUROUS RECEPTION AT RANGOON.

BOYCOTTERS BREAK DOWN

(SINGAPORE SPECIAL AGENTS.) Calcutta, Dec. 29. In view of conflicting accounts of the Prince of Wales's reception at Calcutta, it is officially announced that the impression of disorderly elements into Calcutta on Dec. 28 and 29 to enforce the ban on foreign ships resulted in 450 arrests for obstruction and disorderly conduct.

The total arrests in Calcutta during the past six weeks amount to 3,500. The total in the northern quarter of the city on the Prince's arrival did not go over 1,000. It was found that the willow boom throughout the greater part of the city there were no signs of the ban, while on subsequent days the crowds were enormous and enthusiastic, despite the failure of the efforts to stop the Prince.

In a busy last morning the Prince of Wales walked in a procession from the pier to the city, and on the way he was met by the Governor, the Chief Justice, the Mayor, and other officials.

The Prince, Lord Ripley, in response to the Prince's health, declared the boycotters to be a disgrace to the British Empire.

One of the largest crowds of 10,000 people gathered to greet the Prince of Wales's tour gave H.R.H. a magnificent welcome.

The boycott was manifestly unavailing. It is stated that the organizers of the ban were themselves unable to resist the temptation of the Prince of Wales. The demonstrator of the crowds though occasionally impassive is described as most friendly.

South African Crisis

GREAT COAL STRIKE THREATENED.

(From our S. A. Correspondent.) Cape Town, January 1. South Africa is faced with one of the gravest of industrial crises in its history.

The Transvaal colliers have struck work as a protest against a reduction of five shillings per ton. The Chamber of Mines have proposed the colliers propose to arbitrate.

The situation is greatly complicated by the impending talk of a general gold mine strike for colliers and a general strike, projects in regard to which are retumative 4th January.

All public utilities have laid in great supplies of coal and the railway will be able to run unobstructed for a fortnight or three weeks. Considerable numbers of police have been drafted into the vange area, but at present there is every disposition in the strikes to adopt peaceful methods.

It is stated that it is not intended to impose Martial Law. The ability of some colliers to produce a limited amount of coal with the aid of native black coal is deemed to disappear, owing to the announcement that the mining regulations will be enforced in "white" areas. This is tantamount to the complete closing down of the coal mines.

Meanwhile the first attempt at conciliation has failed, and the colliers have declared that they are unwilling to arbitrate until the Government is satisfied with the members of the Royal Club.

ARRIVAL IN SOUTH AFRICA.

TO SEE SMUTS LATER.

(From an Observatory and Cape Town, Dec. 30. The Convention's delegates arrived at Durban on Wednesday night, and found awaiting them a letter from General Smuts, informing them that he was on tour in Natal, and confirming previous statements of his willingness to meet the Delegation, and asking when they would arrive at Pietermaritzburg to meet him in a date.

On arrival at Pietermaritzburg, the delegates found that General Smuts, through pressure of work in Natal was about to postpone the date of the meeting.

As a result of correspondence which has passed between the delegates in Pretoria and General Smuts in Natal, the Delegation decided to accept General Smuts's offer, that if it was impossible for them to delay their departure from South Africa, they should go to England as arranged, and return to South Africa and see him on their way back.

In view of the necessity of the delegates' return in time to keep their appointment with Mr. Churchill, the delegates felt that they must leave South Africa on December 30 and have accepted General Smuts's invitation to interview him on their way back from England.

Obituary

SIR JOHN HARR, THE VETERAN ACTOR.

London, December 31. The death is announced to-day of Sir John Harr, the English actor.

Sir John Harr was born in 1847, and was 74 years of age, commencing his theatrical career at the age of 20, in Liverpool. The following year he joined the Bancrofts in the great room of the Robertson Comedians; later he went into management on his own, and with Mrs. Kendal, at the St. James's. He quickly made a name, particularly in plays such as "The School for Scandal," "Caste," "A Pair of Spectacles," etc. He appeared in Lytton's "The School for Scandal," and "A Pair of Spectacles" in 1917. He was knighted in 1907.

The death is announced by Sir Thomas Buchanan, G. C. B., M. P., the Vice President of the House of Commons, a Director of the London City and Midland Bank, and a Vice President of the P. and O. Steam Navigation Co., a company he represented in 1914 for seven years. He was formerly a member of the Hong Kong Legislative Council, and was elected to the House of Commons by Greenwich in 1874-1890.
