KENYA INDIANS MR. WOOD STILL UNWILLING TO REPORT. CONTINUED NEGOTIATIONS. FRENCH SEVER'S ANSWER. London, July 11. The question of Indians in Kenya was again raised in the course of the debate on the Colonial Office Vote in the House of Commons when Mr. Wood said he preferred that he and Lord Winterton were committing and hoped to reach an agreement generally acceptable to each of the constituent parties.

Prince of Wales ENTERTAINED AT DINNER BY PRIME MINISTER. London, July 15. Cabinet Ministers and Overseas representatives were present at the dining table given by Mr. Lloyd George in honour of the Prince of Wales.

The Prime Minister in a speech welcoming the Prince said many were doubtful regarding the risk to Kenya under conditions then existing but the Prince of Wales rightly felt it his duty not to wait until the issue was high and until the roses were blooming before visiting India in order to learn to understand the people over whom one day he would reign.

Empire Cotton Ltd. "ILLIMITABLE VISTA" IN EGYPT AND TANGANYIKA. London, July 11. The House of Commons has been invited for a key of experience for members for every 500 pounds of cotton, towards the funds of the corporation.

Moore, M.P., Manchester, in introducing the Bill pointed out that the Egyptian cotton crop only three-twentieths the present production and it was expected only 8,500,000 bales of American cotton would be available this year compared with 13,500,000 bales the year which there was an extraordinary state of cotton supplies from the Sudan and Tanganyika.

WIRELESS CHAIN KENYA TO HAVE NO STATION AT PRESENT. IMPORTANT STATEMENT. (FRENCH SEVER'S ANSWER.) London, July 11. In the House of Commons in answer to questions, Mr. Kellaway, Postmaster General stated that the question of an Imperial Wireless Chain had been decided to erect in England a station in the United Kingdom instead of the smaller power contemplated by the smaller power at this station would provide direct communication with India, South Africa and Australia.

The Imperial Government would not erect the station in India and the station which would also be capable of directly communicating with Brazil, South Africa and Australia.

The proposed second station in Egypt and the station in East Africa would be deferred. The questions of erecting stations at Singapore and Hong Kong would be reconsidered.

The Government were communicating with the Union Government in regard to a station in South Africa and Canada. Negotiations were expected in England to discuss the participation of Canada.

Cape Town, July 17. The Premier in the Legislative Assembly tabled proposals from the Marconi Company with reference to a long distance wireless station. The details are not yet available for publication, but there is good reason to believe that the scheme, acceptable to Government. This means the final abandonment of the Leach/Coleman-Winterton relay scheme in favour of one in which a high power wireless station will be erected in South Africa for direct communication with England.

The company's proposals regarding rates are sixteen pence a word at the full rate, eight pence a word for deferred rates and five pence for press messages and a half pence per word.

BRITISH FINANCE REASSURING STATEMENT BY CHANCELLOR. PAYING AMERICA. (FRENCH SEVER'S ANSWER.) London, July 15. An important statement on Great Britain's financial position was made by Sir Robert Horne in the House of Commons in reply to Mr. French (Lab. Party) on July 11. He said the British debt to America at the present rate of exchange was £125,000,000, the sterling debt had been reduced since July last by £20,000,000. The internal debt of £125,000,000 outstanding in 1922-1923 had been reduced by conversion to £44,000,000.

The Government were constantly giving attention to the debt to America which was a serious obligation which the Government would undoubtedly meet.

The recent request by the United States to transfer the funding of the debt would be completely met. Great Britain's financial position was stronger today than at any time since the Armistice.

The Chancellor believed war would be found to avert the grave economic perils of the world and that Great Britain would play a very great part in this matter.

The Budget. London, July 14. In the House of Commons after insignificant modifications in the nature of Governmental concessions the Budget passed its third reading.

Trade Improving. London, July 12. The Board of Trade returns for June show imports £64,500,000, an increase of £3,075,000 compared with June last year, and exports £52,145,000, an increase of £15,500,000.

A Cairo Tragedy. Cairo, July 15. Lieutenant Colonel Flaggott, Army Pay Department was shot and wounded in the streets of Cairo. It is feared he is fatally injured. His assailants escaped.

The Moplans. Minsk, July 11. Excluding the Moplans, the total number of prisoners in connection with the recent political movement amounts to 2,815.

THE CAPITAL SHIP BRITAIN TO BUILD TWO FOR £10,400,000. BEARING INVULNERABILITY.

(FRENCH SEVER'S ANSWER.) London, July 11. Notwithstanding doubt and subterfuge, the Admiralty believe that it is feasible to build capital ships reasonably prompt against any likely method of attack, said Lord French in the House of Commons. Consequently the Government had decided to recommence their intention to proceed with the construction of two new battleships which with accessories would cost £10,400,000 each and necessitate the scrapping of four existing battleships under the Washington Agreement.

The L. C. C. NEW COUNTY HALL OPENED BY THE KING. London, July 17. The King, accompanied by the Queen, today opened the London County Council's new hall on the south of Westminster Bridge, the building of which was long completed.

The building still lacks a wing and will contain 900 rooms on nine floors. Standing on a site of 67 acres and built in the English Renaissance style the County Hall presents a striking contrast to the House of Parliament.

The King, replying to an Address, also laid the building would accelerate the reconstruction of the south bank of the Thames to wards Blackfriars.

Why Bevan Fled ANXIETY TO COME TO GRIPS WITH CHARGES. Vienna, July 11. Mr Gerard Bevan in an interview with the Standard said he fled to England on February 9 solely at the request of his wife, who had informed him of the arrest of the south bank of the Thames to wards Blackfriars.

He was anxious to come to grips with the grave charges, and he was convinced that nothing dishonourable could be proved. The alleged falsification of balance sheets was an ordinary window-dressing operation.

The official statement of G. L. Bevan for the extradition of G. L. Bevan has reached the Supreme Court. The work of translation and preparation of the mass of documents will occupy at least a month. The final London extradition, will possibly not be reached for some weeks.

LORDS' REFORM GOVERNMENT PUT FORWARD THEIR OPINION. FINANCIAL CONTROL. (FRENCH SEVER'S ANSWER.) London, July 11. In accordance with the Government's reform proposals, the re-constituted House of Lords will contain 100 members of four categories, British, the Royal, Spiritual, and Law Lords, who are permanent, and 50 members elected directly or indirectly from outside; thirty hereditary peers elected by their order; and forty members elected by the Crown.

The right to vote money bills will continue to be withheld from the Lords, but a Joint Committee of the two Houses will replace the Speaker of the House of Commons as the arbiter of what constitutes a money bill.

The Commons' present power to enforce bills is certain since during the lifetime of a single Parliament without the consent of the House of Commons no bill can be introduced, and the House of Commons is a permanent body.

The Honours Problem ROYAL COMMISSION TO GUIDE PRIME MINISTER. London, July 15. A long controversy on the subject of the conferral of honours has been ventilated in the House of Commons and the House of Lords, where motions standing in the name of a large and influential section of the Members of Parliament were debated.

The Prime Minister announced the appointment of a Royal Commission to assist Prime Ministers in recommending honours.

The Government had decided to restore to the House of Commons confidence, but the motion in the House of Commons was tabled out of the Lords was withdrawn.

Sir H. Wilson MURDERED SENTENCED. London, July 18. Dunn and O'Sullivan have been sentenced to death for the murder of Field Marshal Sir Henry Wilson.

Items from France Paris, July 17. The largest power station in the world has been erected at Ghentville; it is opening, besides the new station, at Nantes, Lyons, Corbeil and Orleans.

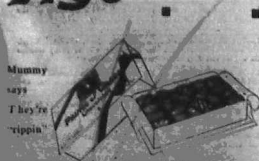

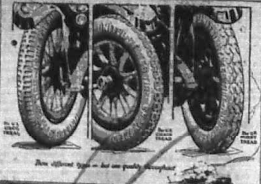

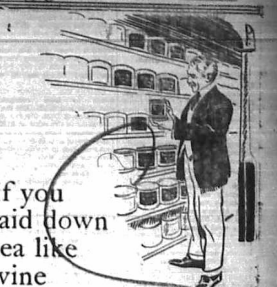
