## LONDON NOTES.

A Meeting on the Indian  
Demand.

## UNAMINOUS RESOLUTION.

(From Our Own Correspondent.)  
London, January 31.

There has been great excitement over the Indian demand, and Saturday, January 27, a public meeting was held at the Royal Institute of British Architects, London, nearly thirty people present. It was on the motion of Mr. Morgan, the president of the Royal Institute of Architects, that it was decided to be held on Tuesday, January 30, when Mr. Powys Cobb, General Whately, and Mr. Morgan, would speak before a large audience.

On Tuesday, January 30, a public meeting was held at the hotel which was attended by nearly 200 persons, including a number of Sir Mal Mervin, Mr. John Hall, Mr. Morgan, Mr. Powys Cobb, and others who were very prominent in the Colonies.

Mr. Powys Cobb spoke of the situation in India, and the leak out of the granting of the Indian demands. He outlined the date on which the country if the Indian resolution would be equated with Reparation. He also mentioned disintegration of the Empire, as this country would be more dependent on India.

## The Indian Scheme.

In answer to a question he defined "the Indian scheme" as follows: "that the Indian agitation was engineered by a few extremists, and that it had to do with re-opening the date of the termination of the settlers of Leonidas, and that it was to be submitted to the Government of India."

Capt. Preston proposed a committee, which would have opportunities for discussion, and read the Indian scheme as a document to the members of the Royal Engineers.

Capt. Preston accused Mr. Cobb of misrepresenting facts. He was asked if he had any objection to be seated, but was advised to conclude his speech.

A heated discussion followed.

Major Denton spoke in support of the resolution, and had some time left to say about it.

General Whately then spoke. He urged his hearers to abstain from the discussion, and to pass the resolution at smaller meetings.

Mr. Cobb appealed to all present that he had not registered a vote to do so at once.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the speakers.



We admit the right of Indians "to live and move and have their being" in Kenya. We do not say that they have no objection to their undertaking the conduct of their own concerns, but we do say that they have no objection to allow them anything approaching a share in the management of our affairs. Moderate minded Indians will perhaps understand that our attitude is not that of the Indian Nationalists. But if this is not an admission of weakness, but an admission of the real issue, then we have got out of the way as far as to allow us to get into the real issue, which is probably wider than they have as yet realised.
