## ENGLISH ATHLETICS

Universities Hold Their  
Annual Sports

### NEW RECORDS SET UP

(From Our Own Correspondent.)

Clashings of important features  
and new records at this season  
of the year and the Saturday fixture  
has just gone by supplied another  
instance of such occurrences. For  
that matter, for the first time in  
the history of the event, the  
meetings were not of a kind to  
excite the interest of the public.

They were principally those in  
which Academic athletes, confined  
to provincial and other Universities  
and seats of learning and training  
for the most serious affairs of life,  
were the candidates for the  
honours in the sports and pastimes  
of their choice.

The results were  
encouraging to those enthusiasts  
who are searching for the necessary  
facility for exhibiting Great Britain's  
prevalence in sports that year on the  
occasion of the Olympic Games.

Most was learnt last time at the  
University of Cambridge and  
University of Oxford, and it is  
possible to form a shrewd idea of  
what may be expected from the  
results in other events.

Liverpool University sports were  
chiefly noticeable for the fine  
display given by the runner, Rugby  
footballer, B. H. Maxwell, and the  
footballing International, J. W.  
Thwaites. The latter was good  
fast flyer; but he is better now; for  
while winning the 100 yards in

21 feet 1 1/2 inches and the 220

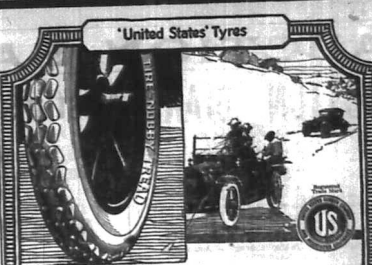

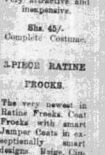

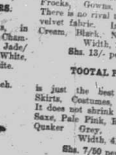

## KENYA AND THE UNION

Why South Africa Must Take  
 Up the Cudgels.

### SOUTHERN OPINION.

In the continuance of the  
 Birmingham Press prints the fol-  
 lowing leading article entitled  
 "Kenya and the Union."  
 "The Kenya question has now  
 developed into one of the most im-  
 portant for the whole British Com-  
 monwealth. To South Africa it is  
 of the most vital concern."  
 "Not only is the question of In-  
 dian immigration into Central or  
 Southern Africa one of the self-  
 preservation of the White race in  
 that continent, but it comes closely  
 into contact in Kenya at least  
 with South Africa's great problem  
 of the Native."  
 "The Indian propaganda de-  
 ceals that in a letter drawn up  
 in London in the part of India in  
 the administration of the  
 Native, and the view, expressed  
 by Mr. Alsworth, late Native  
 Commissioner in the East African  
 Protectorate, has been called  
 for in London."  
 "His point is that whatever the  
 settlement of the present Kenya  
 problem may be, there must be a  
 question of Natives being subjected  
 to the vagaries of the present  
 British Government, he  
 says, is their proper guardian, and  
 that guardianship must be  
 maintained who had no right to  
 demand, and, therefore, whatever is  
 decided as regards the present  
 rule the Native should be left out  
 of the business."  
 Inevitable Development.  
 "The reply to this is, of course,  
 that the Native cannot be left out  
 of the business. The Indian demand  
 is for equality with the Europeans  
 in Kenya. This includes the fran-  
 chise and the right of election to  
 whatever constitutional bodies form  
 the Government of the territory."  
 "Kenya will not always remain  
 a Crown Colony. One day it will  
 get responsible Government. The  
 position then will be that the In-  
 dian will sit in Parliament with  
 his own power actually to influ-  
 ence the whole Administration of  
 the country and, consequently, as  
 "Sooner or later the Natives will  
 become subject to the Government  
 and will necessarily follow that the  
 Indian will become an equal part  
 of the Natives."  
 "If we would not any longer  
 insist that the White race of  
 South Africa cannot possibly con-  
 cele with any such a position, we  
 of an additional ruling factor  
 and of another type of Government  
 further to complete the Native  
 problem."  
 South Africa's Part.  
 "At the present moment there is  
 a real danger of the British Gov-  
 ernment and British public opinion
